A1 Basis of Preparation

The interim financial report of Wegmans Holdings Berhad ("Wegmans" or "the Company") and its subsidiaries ("the Group") are unaudited and have been prepared in accordance with MFRS 134: "Interim Financial Reporting" issued by the Malaysian Accounting Standards Board and Rule 9.22 of the Listing Requirements.

The interim financial report should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2019 and the accompanying explanatory notes attached to this interim financial report.

A12 Material Subsequent Events

On 13 January 2020, there was a minor fire incident which occurred at certain section in one of three factories located at Lot PTD 6967, Jalan Kempas 3, Kawasan Perindustrian Bakri, 84200 Muar, Johor owned by a wholly-owned subsidiary of the Company, Wegmans Furniture Industries Sdn. Bhd.("WFI"). The incident affected one of the spraying lines and certain inventory work-in-progress.

The damages arising from the fire incident are approximately RM0.81 million, which had been recognised in profit or loss for the financial quarter ended 31 March 2020.

On 10 July 2020, the insurer had made a payment of RM0.85 million to WFI, being the full and final settlement of the fire incident claim.

Save as disclosed above, there were no other material events subsequent to the end of the current financial period that have not been reflected in the interim financial reports for the said period as at the date of this report.

The Group's revenue for the current financial quarter ended 30 June 2020 has decreased by RM5.46 million or 27.91% to approximately RM14.10 million as compared to approximately RM19.56 million in the preceding year corresponding quarter ended 30 June 2019.

For the financial period ended 30 June 2020, the Group's revenue has decreased by RM6.10 million or 14.51% to approximately RM35.97 million as compared to approximately RM42.07 million in the preceding corresponding financial period ended 30 June 2019.

The lower revenue was mainly due to the implementation of Movement Control Order ("MCO") by the Malaysian Government from 18 March 2020 and the COVID-19 pandemic. The imposition of the MCO had impacted the Group's operations during the quarter under review as production operations and deliveries were significantly curtailed. We also had to reschedule the original shipments during the MCO period to a later date, due to lockdown or shutdown of activities in the affected countries.

Under the MCO, all government and private premises except those involved in providing essential services were closed until 3 May 2020. Although the Group's operations were listed as nonessential services, our operations were not fully suspended as we had obtained approval from Malaysian Timber Industry Board, whereby 50% of the workforce were allowed to resume work on 27 March 2020 subject to standard operating procedures ("SOP") imposed by the government of Malaysia. Subsequently, with the commencement of conditional MCO on 4 May 2020, 100% of the workforce were allowed to work with the condition of following strictly the SOP.

The Group registered a loss before tax of approximately RM1.30 million for the current financial quarter ended 30 June 2020 as compared to profit before tax of approximately RM3.16 million for the preceding year corresponding quarter ended 30 June 2019.

For the current financial period ended 30 June 2020, the Group registered a loss before tax of approximately RM0.81 million as compared to profit before tax of approximately RM4.82 million for the preceding corresponding financial period ended 30 June 2019.

The loss before tax was mainly due to lower revenue arising from the temporary disruption of our operations as a result of the imposition of the MCO to control the COVID-19 pandemic. The temporary interruptions to our production operations had then resulted in higher fixed costs and labour costs as optimum production capacity could not be achieved.

B2 Comparison with Immediate Preceding Quarter Results

The Group's revenue for the current financial quarter ended 30 June 2020 has decreased by RM7.76 million or 35.51% to approximately RM14.10 million as compared to approximately RM21.87 million in the preceding financial quarter ended 31 March 2020. The lower revenue was mainly due to the implementation of MCO from 18 March 2020 and the COVID-19 pandemic.

The Group registered a loss before tax of approximately RM1.30 million for the current financial quarter as compared to profit before tax of approximately RM0.49 million for the preceding financial quarter. The loss before tax was mainly due to the lower revenue.

B3 Prospects for the Current Financial Year

The Group is principally involved in the design, manufacture and sale of home furniture products, where it operates in 4 principal geographical areas (i.e. Asia, North and South America, Australasia and Europe). The furniture industries the Group operates in are highly sensitive to macroeconomic factors particularly the general economy and uncertainties surrounding the future economic prospects of the countries it exports to.

In view of the weak market sentiments following the outbreak of COVID-19, the Group will endeavour to increase its product range and designs in addition to identifying export markets which will face a greater economic recovery rate from COVID-19. This will help the Group to expand and diversify its customer base in order to enhance its resilience to face any future crisis.

The Group believes that 2020 will be a challenging year. However, the Group has identified a window of opportunity where we can capitalise on. Our target export market is North America especially the United States of America where the demand remains healthy despite the pandemic.

In addition, the Board will continue to monitor the status and progress of COVID-19 and will regularly review the performance and progress of the Group's operations and financial performance as well as introduce measures to minimise its operating costs, if required. The Board expects that the Group's prospects for the financial year ending 31 December 2020 to be challenging but satisfactory.
