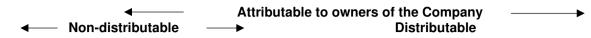

A16. Fair value information

The carrying amounts of cash and cash equivalents, short-term receivables and payables reasonably approximate their fair values due to the relatively short-term nature of these financial instruments and insignificant impact of discounting.

The carrying amounts of long-term floating rate borrowings approximate their fair value as the borrowings will be repriced to market interest rate on or near reporting date.

A17. Holding Company

The Directors regard Aurora Meadow Sdn Bhd, a company incorporated in Malaysia, as the holding company.

B. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION REQUIRED BY THE LISTING REQUIREMENTS

B1. Review of Financial Performance

The Group recorded a revenue of approximately RM25.45 million and RM43.84 million in the current financial quarter and the cumulative financial quarter ended 30 November 2021 respectively. The Group's revenue is mainly contributed by the sales of paper-based packaging.

The Group recorded a profit before tax of approximately RM2.04 million and RM4.70 million in the current financial quarter and cumulative financial quarter ended 30 November 2021.

B2. Variation of Results Against Corresponding Quarter

The Group registered a lower revenue of approximately RM25.45 million and RM43.84 million in the current financial quarter and the cumulative financial quarter as compared to approximately RM31.21 million and RM57.90 million in the corresponding financial quarter and the corresponding cumulative financial quarter respectively. The decrease in revenue by approximately 18.44% in the current financial quarter against its revenue for the corresponding financial quarter was mainly due to (i) lower contribution from the trading of rigid box segment; and (ii) lower sales of paper-based packaging to its customers in particular the consumer electrical & electronics and food and beverage industries.

The overall gross profit margin reduced from approximately 28.48% and 26.89% in the corresponding financial quarter and the corresponding cumulative financial quarter respectively to approximately 21.08% and 22.76% in the current financial quarter and the cumulative financial quarter respectively. Such decrease was mainly due to lower revenue as well as higher production cost such as staff cost (including the share-based payment resulting from the granting of employees' share option scheme ("ESOS") options to the eligible production staff during the current financial quarter under review).

In line with the lower revenue, the Group also recorded a lower profit before tax of RM2.04 million and RM4.70 million in the current financial quarter and the cumulative financial quarter respectively as compared to approximately RM6.12 million and RM11.18 million in the corresponding financial quarter and the corresponding cumulative financial quarter respectively.

B3. Variation of Results Against Immediate Preceding Quarter

The Group registered a higher revenue of approximately RM25.45 million in the current financial quarter as compared to approximately RM18.39 million in the preceding financial quarter. The increase in revenue was mainly because the Group is allowed to resume 100% operating capacity starting from 18 September 2021.

Notwithstanding the higher revenue, the overall gross profit margin reduced from approximately 25.08% in the preceding financial quarter to approximately 21.08% in the current financial quarter mainly due to the share-based payment for production staff as elaborated in Note B2.

As a result of the share-based payment, the Group recorded a lower profit before tax of approximately RM2.04 million in the current financial quarter as compared to approximately RM2.66 million in the preceding financial quarter.

B4. Commentary on Prospects

In light of the uncertainties caused by the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, the Board believes that the Group needs to be responsive to the economic and market developments, domestically, regionally and globally, as to their impact on its business. While the Group does have its business plans in place, there may be a need to improvise with these as the Group moves forward. The realities may warrant the exercise of prudence to delay certain plans in certain situation, or to modify, and even accelerate plans in order to capture growth opportunities of new positive developments, which are deemed sustainable.

According to the World Economic Outlook October 2021 published by International Momentary Fund, the global economy is projected to grow at 4.9% in 2022. The Malaysian gross domestic product's growth performance is supported mainly by the improvement in domestic demand and continued robust exports performance, particularly for electronic and electrical ("E&E") products. With the Government's continuous initiative for COVID-19 vaccine and booster shot, the Board believes that consumer spending level will remain constant during this pandemic with minimal disruption to most businesses that continue to operate and supported by the acceleration in online shopping. Taking these into account, the Board is optimistic that the prospects of E&E industry will remain positive and will augur well for the Group's business.

Moving forward, the Group will further explore new business opportunities arising from the radical shift in consumers' behaviour to online shopping. The Group will also look into expanding the range of packaging products by offering innovative solutions that would appeal to its existing customers and to attract potential new customers.

While local market demand will remain the mainstay of the Group's business, the Board envisages that there will be new opportunities arising in the ASEAN region as the global economy slowly opens up further. The Board sees that this will also give the Group further impetus for growth and the Group is well positioned to seize such opportunities to expand its paper-based packaging business.

Furthermore, in response to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Group has and will continue to implement various precautionary measures at its factories and offices to minimise the risk of COVID-19 infections and to ensure compliance with the standard operating procedures imposed by the Government. As at 21 October 2021, the Group's employees have completed 2 doses of COVID-19 vaccine.

Premised on the above and after taking into consideration the potential impact brought upon by the COVID-19 pandemic, the Board is cautiously optimistic of the Group's prospects for the financial year ending 31 May 2022.
