1. Review of results

1.1 Results of the current year-to-date ("YTD") against preceding YTD (YTD 1st Quarter 2011 versus YTD 1st Quarter 2010)

Operating revenue

The Group recorded an increase in operating revenue by 4.3% or RM27.1 million. The increase was due mainly to the higher gross earned premiums and investment income of RM15.2 million and RM11.9 million respectively.

Profit before tax

Profit before tax of the Group increased by 47.9% or RM17.1 million. The increase was due mainly to the increase of underwriting profit from general insurance business.

The profit for the period under review excludes any surplus to be transferred from the Life fund to the Shareholders' fund which will be determined at the financial year end after the annual valuation of the Life fund's liabilities has been carried out by the appointed actuary.

1.2 Results of the current quarter against the preceding quarter (1st Quarter 2011 versus 4th Quarter 2010)

Operating revenue

Operating revenue decreased by 1.6% or RM10.4 million due mainly to lower gross earned premium from the life insurance business.

Profit before tax

The profit before tax of the Group for the quarter under review decreased by 14.5% or RM8.9 million due mainly to the transfer of surplus of RM15.0 million from the Life fund to the Shareholders' fund in the preceding quarter, which was performed on an annual basis.

2. Current year prospects

The Group continues with its initiatives to invest in distribution capabilities and to strengthen top line growth and profitability.

The Group is expected to grow in tandem with the economy and the insurance industry in Malaysia. The Board is of the view that the Group will perform well in 2011.

3. Profit forecast

The Group did not issue any profit forecast or profit guarantee as at the date of this report.
