Notes to Interim Financial Report

B. Explanatory Notes as required by the Bursa Securities' Listing Requirements

B1. Detailed analysis of performance 3rd Quarter FY 2012 vs 3rd Quarter FY 2011

The Group revenue for the current quarter under review was RM82.5 million, 13% higher than RM72.9 million in the corresponding quarter last year. All segments reported higher revenues except for Investment Holding. However, Group profit before tax dropped 43% to RM122.9 million (2011: RM214.8 million) mainly affected by lower profit contribution from our plantation associate, KLK.

After equity accounting of KLK's results, profit before tax from **Investment Holding** was RM111.6 million, 46% lower (2011: RM205.0 million), mainly due to KLK's lower profit contribution affected by lower commodity selling prices and lower FFB production.

Chemicals sector reported a 14% increase in revenue to RM74.3 million from RM64.9 million contributed by higher sales volumes and higher products' selling prices. Profit before tax was higher at RM11.8 million (2011: RM11.0 million) which benefited from a RM5.0 million (2011: Nil) non-fulfillment of chemical off-takes compensation claim against a customer.

Investment Property sector's revenue was RM1.6 million, 33% higher compared to the RM1.2 million reported last corresponding quarter, due to higher occupancy rate which resulted in a profit before tax of RM635,000 (2011: RM93,000).

Our Indonesian **Plantations**' subsidiary recorded revenue of RM6.1 million, similar to last corresponding period despite higher FFB crop harvested (2012: 10,440 mt vs 2011: 9,638 mt) from an increased mature area of 3,087 ha (2011: 2,516 ha) as FFB price was 7% lower. Hence, a higher loss of RM1.1 million (2011: RM382,000 loss) was reported due to a 7% increase in FFB cost.

Todate 3rd Quarter FY 2012 vs Todate 3rd Quarter FY 2011

For the current period, Group profit before tax was RM413.8 million, 26% lower than the RM556.3 million reported last year, despite a 20% increase in revenue. All segments reported higher profits except for Investment Holding.

Revenue from **Investment Holding** was lower at RM17.9 million (2011: RM19.8 million) due to reduced surplus cash invested in short term trust funds and lower dividend income. Profit before tax, after equity accounting of KLK's results, was RM383.2 million (2011: RM535.2 million), decreased 28% due to KLK's lower profit from lower commodity selling prices and lower FFB production.

Chemicals sector's revenue was RM215.6 million, 19% higher than the RM181.1 million reported last corresponding period, from higher sales volumes and higher products' selling prices which resulted in a higher profit before tax at RM31.1 million (2011: RM28.0 million). The current period's profit also benefited from a RM10.2 million (2011: Nil) compensation claim against a customer for deferred deliveries and non-fulfillment of chemical off-takes.

Profit before tax of **Investment Property** sector rose to RM1.8 million (2011: RM51,000) resulting from higher revenue at RM4.7 million (2011: RM3.2 million), contributed by increase in occupancy rate.

Revenue of our Indonesian **Plantations**' subsidiary improved 36% to RM28.1 million (2011: RM20.7 million) due to higher FFB crop harvested (2012: 46,118 mt vs 2011: 31,787 mt) from an increased mature area of 3,087 ha (2011: 2,516 ha). Accordingly, profit before tax increased 161% to RM7.3 million from RM2.8 million last corresponding period.

B2. Comparison of current quarter's results to the preceding quarter

Pre-tax profit for the current quarter was RM122.9 million, 4% higher than the RM118.0 million reported in the preceding quarter. This was mainly due to our plantation associate's (KLK) marginally higher after-tax profit.

B3. Current year's prospects

Notwithstanding the lower profit from our plantation associate, Kuala Lumpur Kepong Berhad, the Group's profit for the financial year ending 30 September 2012 is expected to be reasonably satisfactory.

Profit from Chemicals sector is expected to be sustained due to expected growth in sales volumes despite higher production costs.
