a) Accounting Policies

The interim financial report is unaudited and has been prepared in accordance with Financial Reporting Standard ("FRS") 134 "Interim Financial Reporting" and paragraph 9.22 of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad. - 1) Detailed Analysis of the Performance of all Operating Segments of the Group
- a) Q3 FY2012 vs. Q3 FY2011

The Group reported a pre-tax profit of RM659.3 million for Q3 FY2012, which is 16% lower than the profit of RM780.9 million reported for Q3 FY2011. The lower profit is due mainly to decrease in overall operating profit of the group, except for property investment segment.

Plantation

The plantation segment profit decreased by 11% to RM303.2 million for Q3 FY2012, as compared to RM341.6 million reported for Q3 FY2011. The lower profit reported is due to lower FFB production as well as higher cost of production. FFB production for Q3 FY2012 was 644,984 MT as compared to 676,197 MT for Q3 FY2011 i.e. a decrease of about 5%.

Resource-based Manufacturing

The resource-based manufacturing profit decreased from RM191.7 million in Q3 FY2011 to RM89.1 million in Q3 FY2012. After excluding the changes in fair value on derivative contracts amounting to a loss of RM4.9 million (Q3 FY2011 – gain of RM99.1 million), the results of resource-based manufacturing segment in Q3 FY2012 is consistent with the results in Q3 FY2011.

Property Development

The segment results from property development division of RM110.1 million for Q3 FY2012 is 25% lower than the profit reported for Q3 FY2011 of RM145.9 million. The lower profit from the segment is due mainly to lower development revenue recognised as well as decrease in share of results from jointly controlled entities.

Property Investment

Operating profit from property investment segment for Q3 FY2012 is 18% higher than Q3 FY2011 as a result of increase in overall average rental per square foot.

b) Q3 YTD FY2012 vs. Q3 YTD FY2011

For Q3 YTD FY2012, the Group reported a pre-tax profit of RM1,850.3 million, which is 13% lower than the profit of RM2,131.9 million reported for Q3 YTD FY2011. The decrease is due mainly to translation loss on foreign currency denominated borrowings of RM93.3 million (Q3 YTD FY2011 – gain of RM250.8 million).

Plantation

The plantation segment reported a 22% increase in operating profit to RM1,322.7 million for Q3 YTD FY2012, as compared to RM1,086.1 million reported for Q3 YTD FY2011. The higher profit reported is due mainly to higher CPO price realised of RM3,107/MT (Q3 YTD FY2011 – RM2,794/MT) and higher FFB production of 2,521,260 MT (Q3 YTD FY2011 – 2,375,687 MT).

Resource-based Manufacturing

The resource-based manufacturing segment reported a profit of RM246.5 million for Q3 YTD FY2012, 28% lower than profit of RM340.3 million reported for Q3 YTD FY2011. The lower profit reported is mainly due to fair value differences on derivative contracts. The segment reported RM85.9 million loss on changes in fair value of derivative contracts for Q3 YTD FY2012 whilst there was a fair value gain of RM2.7 million for Q3 YTD FY2011.

Property Development

The property development segment's operating profit of RM359.2 million for Q3 YTD FY2012 is 15% lower than profit of RM424.8 million for Q3 YTD FY2011 as a result of slower take up rates in line with the more cautious market sentiments.

Property Investment

Operating profit of RM42.1 million from property investment segment for Q3 YTD FY2012 is lower than Q3 YTD FY2011 by 58% (approximately RM59.1 million) as the profit in Q3 YTD FY2011 included gain on disposal of an investment property amounting to RM61 million.

2) Material Change in Profit Before Taxation for the Current Quarter as Compared with the Immediate Preceding Quarter

The Group reported a pre-tax profit of RM659.3 million for Q3 FY2012, which is 14% lower than the profit reported for Q2 FY2012 of RM766.8 million. It is mainly due to lower operating profits in all segments which however mitigated by higher translation gain on foreign currency denominated borrowings.

The decrease of plantation segment results by 34% to RM303.2 million for Q3 FY2012 as compared to RM462.3 million for Q2 FY2012 is due mainly to lower FFB production of 644,984 MT (Q2 FY2012 – 902,983 MT).

Contribution from the property segment for Q3 FY2012 of RM123.9 million is lower than the preceding quarter by 23%, due mainly to lower development revenue recognised.

The resource-based manufacturing segment reported a profit of RM89.1 million in Q3 FY2012, 28% lower than Q2 FY2012, due mainly to lower sales volume.

The plantation segment is expected to perform well for the current financial year on the back of resilient crude palm oil prices.

The Malaysian property market outlook remains positive especially in the landed property segment. The Group anticipates stronger sales with more property launches in the coming quarter. In Singapore, the continued resilient performance of the mass market segment will ensure that the Group's more recent mass market projects continue to do well although the high-end market segment is still affected by uncertainty in the global economic environment.

The resource-based manufacturing segment continues to face challenging times ahead but is supported by resilient demand from the food industry for specialty oils and fats and the improving oleochemical performance.

13) Material Litigations

There are no new material litigation or significant changes to the status of material litigations which are pending disposal in the courts since 30 June 2011. For ease of reference, the material litigations brought forward are detailed below:

a) IOI Corporation Berhad

A civil suit had been instituted by Tuan Haji Zulkifli Bin Hussain and 6 others, the former shareholders of IOI Oleochemical Industries Berhad ("IOI Oleo") against the Company, its Executive Chairman Tan Sri Dato' Lee Shin Cheng and its Executive Director, Dato' Lee Yeow Chor. The Writ of Summons and the Statement of Claim, inter alia, alleged that the defendants are under an obligation pursuant to Rule 34.1 of the Malaysian Code on Take-Overs and Mergers, 1987 to extend a mandatory general offer to the plaintiffs to acquire their shares in IOI Oleo and have sought for damages by reason of alleged failure by the defendants to extend the said general offer.

The plaintiffs' claim in this suit is based on similar facts that gave rise to the mandamus proceeding initiated by the first plaintiff in the High Court of Kuala Lumpur against the Securities Commission (the Company and Tan Sri Dato' Lee Shin Cheng were subsequently allowed to be joined as parties to the said mandamus proceeding) which has been struck off.

The trial for this case concluded on 6 May 2010 and the High Court had on 20 May 2011 dismissed the plaintiffs' case with costs. The plaintiffs have filed an appeal to the Court of Appeal against the decision of the High Court.

The Company had been advised by its solicitors that it has genuine and valid defences to advance against the plaintiffs' cause of actions and the claims made therein.

b) Unipamol Malaysia Sdn Bhd and Pamol Plantations Sdn Bhd (subsidiaries of IOI Oleochemical Industries Berhad)

A legal suit had been instituted by Joseph bin Paulus Lantip, Mairin @ Martin bin Idang, Jaskri Doyou, Saffar bin Jumat @ Beklin bin Jumat, Datuk Miller Munang and George Windom Munang (collectively, the "Plaintiffs") against Unipamol Malaysia Sdn Bhd ("Unipamol"), Pamol Plantations Sdn Bhd ("PPSB"), Unilever plc and its subsidiary Pamol (Sabah) Ltd (collectively the "Defendants"). The Writ of Summons and Statement of Claim are dated 4 December 2002 and inter-alia, alleged that the Defendants have wrongfully refused or failed to continue with the Share Sale Agreement (to which PPSB is a party but not Unipamol) and Shareholders' Agreement (to which both PPSB and Unipamol are parties). The Plaintiffs are claiming for, inter-alia, special damages of RM43.47 million, general damages of RM136.85 million or such amount as may be assessed, exemplary damages, interest and costs. Unipamol and PPSB have entered an appearance and filed a Defence to the claim as well as a Counter-claim against the Plaintiffs.

The 3rd and 4th defendants have filed an appeal against the decision of the High Court delivered on 14 January 2010 dismissing their application to strike out the claim against them. On 13 October 2010, the Court of Appeal allowed the 3rd defendant's appeal but dismissed the 4th defendant's appeal. The Plaintiffs have since filed an application for leave to appeal to the Federal Court on the decision of the Court of Appeal in allowing the 3rd defendant's appeal.

The High Court has on 3 December 2010 struck off the Plaintiffs' Writ of Summons and Statement of Claim due to procedural non-compliance subject to the Plaintiffs' right to apply for reinstatement. The Plaintiffs' Solicitors have subsequently filed an application to reinstate the Writ of Summons and Statement of Claim. On 10 March 2011, the High Court dismissed the Plaintiffs' application for reinstatement and the Plaintiffs have filed an appeal against the said decision to the Court of Appeal and the Court of Appeal has allowed the Plaintiffs' appeal on 12 December 2011. The matter has been presently fixed for hearing from 25 to 29 of June 2012.

Meanwhile, the Plaintiffs' application for leave to appeal to the Federal Court (against the decision of the Court of Appeal to strike off the 3rd defendant as a party) has been allowed. The Federal Court has completed the hearing for the said appeal on 29 May 2012 and decision is reserved.

Unipamol and PPSB have obtained favourable legal opinion on the merits of the case.
