## A Explanatory notes - FRS 134 : Interim Financial Reporting

#### A 1 Basis of preparation

The interim financial report has been prepared in accordance with FRS 134: Interim Financial Reporting and Chapter 9 Part K of the Main Market Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad.

The interim financial report is unaudited and should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2011.

The same accounting policies and methods of computation are followed in the interim financial report as compared with the annual financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2011 except for the adoption of new standards, amendments to standards and IC interpretations that are mandatory for the Group for the financial year beginning 1 January 2012. The adoption of these standards, amendments and interpretations do not have a material impact on the interim financial statements of the Group.

### Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards (MFRS Framework)

On 19 November 2011, the Malaysian Accounting Standards Board (MASB) issued a new MASB approved accounting framework, the Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards (MFRS Framework).

The MFRS Framework is to be applied by all Entities Other Than Private Entities for annual periods beginning on or after 1 January 2012, with the exception of entities that are within the scope of MFRS 141 Agriculture (MFRS 141) and IC Interpretation 15 Agreements for Construction of Real Estate (IC 15), including its parent, significant investor and venturer (herein called "Transitioning Entities").

Transitioning Entities will be allowed to defer adoption of the new MFRS Framework for an additional one year. Consequently, adoption of the MFRS Framework by Transitioning Entities will be mandatory for annual periods beginning on or after 1 January 2013.

The Group falls within the scope definition of Transitioning Entities and accordingly, will be required to prepare financial statements using the MFRS Framework in its first MFRS financial statements for the year ending 31 December 2013. In presenting its first MFRS financial statements, the Group will be required to restate the comparative financial statements to amounts reflecting the application of MFRS Framework. The majority of the adjustments required on transition will be made, retrospectively, against opening retained profits.

The Group has commenced transitioning its accounting policies and financial reporting from the current Financial Reporting Standards to MFRS Framework. At the date of these interim financial statements, the Group has not completed its quantification of the financial effects of the differences between Financial Reporting Standards and accounting standards under the MFRS Framework due to the ongoing assessment. Accordingly, the financial performance and financial position as disclosed in these financial statements for the year ending 31 December 2012 could be different if prepared under the MFRS Framework.

The Group considers that it is achieving its schedules milestones and expects to be in a position to fully comply with the requirements of the MFRS Framework for the financial year ending 31 December 2013.

The extensive disclosures of qualitative and quantitative information about exposures to risks from financial instruments as required by FRS 7 will be made in the audited annual financial statements of the Group.

### A 2 Seasonal or cyclical nature of operations

The revenue and earnings are impacted by the production of fresh fruit bunches and volatility of the selling prices of fresh fruit bunches, crude palm oil and palm kernel.

The production of fresh fruit bunches depends on weather conditions, production cycle of the palms and the age of the palms.

## B Information as required by the Main Market Listing Requirements (Part A of Appendix 9B) of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad

#### **B 1** Review of performance

During the first financial quarter and three months under review, revenue decreased by 27.28% when compared with the previous corresponding financial quarter and period due mainly to substantial decreases in the average selling prices and production of ffb, crude palm oil and palm kernel.

The decrease in the production of ffb is due cyclical factors as well as the replanting of old and low yield palms.

Overall expenses were higher due mainly to increase in the application of fertiliser.

Overall, profit before tax decreased by 63.02% due to substantial decreases in the average selling prices and production of ffb, crude palm oil and palm kernel.

## B 2 Material change in the profit before tax for the first financial quarter compared with the immediate preceding quarter

Revenue in the first financial quarter under review decreased by 20.22% when compared with the immediate preceding financial quarter due mainly to substantial decreases in the production of ffb, crude palm oil and palm kernel. The average selling prices of ffb and crude palm oil were higher. However, the average selling price of palm kernel was lower.

The decrease in the production of ffb is due cyclical factors as well as the replanting of old and low yield palms.

In the preceding financial quarter there was an unfavourable adjustment of RM4,400,000 representing the decrease in the fair value of biological assets recognised in the income statement arising from the valuation of biological assets performed by a professional valuer.

Overall, profit before tax decreased by 32.53% due mainly to decreases in the production of ffb, crude palm oil and palm kernel.

However, excluding the adjustment in the fair value of biological assets, profit before tax decreased by 56.53% due mainly to decreases in the production of ffb, crude palm oil and palm kernel.

## B 3 Prospects for financial year ending 31 December 2012

Since the end of the previous financial year, the selling price of crude palm oil has been volatile. Should this trend continue, it will affect the financial performance for the financial year ending 31 December 2012.

#### B 4 Variance of actual profit from forecast profit and shortfall in profit guarantee

There were no profit forecasts prepared for public release and profit guarantees provided by the Group.

On 10 April 2006, the Company entered into a conditional joint venture and shareholders agreement with Timor Oil Palm Plantation Berhad, a 58.0% owned subsidiary of the Company, Eng Thye Plantations Berhad, an 83.3% owned subsidiary of the Company, Seong Thye Plantations Sdn Bhd, Chin Teck Plantations Berhad and Chin Thye Investment Pte Ltd ('Singapore JVSA') to participate in a joint venture project for the development of an oil palm plantation in Indonesia with P.T. Lampung Karya Indah. ('Proposed Joint Venture'), the details of which are set out in the Circular to Shareholders dated 11 May 2006.

The approval of the Shareholders of the Company was obtained at the Extraordinary General Meeting of the Company held on 26 May 2006.

The conditions precedent as set out in the Singapore JVSA have been fulfilled and the necessary approvals required for the subscription of shares in Chin Thye Investment Pte Ltd have been obtained.
