# Part A – NOTES PURSUANT TO MALAYSIAN FINANCIAL REPORTING STANDARD 134 ("MFRS 134")

# A1. First-time Adopting of Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards ("MFRS")

The condensed consolidation interim financial statements of the Group for the period ended 31 December 2012, have been prepared in accordance with MFRS 134 Interim Financial Reporting and paragraph 9.2 of the Listing Requirement of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad. These condensed consolidated interim financial also comply with IAS 34 Interim Financial Reporting issued by the International Accounting Standards Board. For the periods up to and including the year ended 30<sup>th</sup> June 2012, the Group prepared its financial statements in accordance with Financial Reporting Standards ("FRS").

The Group has adopted the MFRS framework issued by MASB with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> July 2012. This MFRS framework was introduced by MASB in order to fully converge Malaysia's existing FRS framework with the IAS framework issued by the IASB.

#### A1.1 Significant Accounting Policies and Application of MFRS 1

These condensed consolidated interim financial statements are the Group's first MFRS condensed consolidated interim financial statements for part of the period covered by the Group's first MFRS annual financial statements for the year ending 30<sup>th</sup> June 2013. The Group has therefore applied MFRS 1 – First-time Adopting of Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards.

The adoption of the MFRS framework did not result in any substantial change to the Group's accounting policies, nor any significant impact on the financial statements, as the accounting policies adopted by the Group under the previous FRS framework are consistent with the MFRS framework, except for the following:

#### (a) Business combination

MFRS 1 provides the option to apply MFRS 3 Business Combinations, prospectively from the date of transition or from a specific date prior to the date of transition. This provides relief from combinations prior to the date of transition.

## Acquisitions before date of transition

The Group has elected to apply MFRS 3 prospectively from the date of transition. In respect of acquisitions prior to the date of transition,

#### (a) Business combination

- (i) The classification of former business combinations under FRS is maintained;
- (ii) There is no re-measurement of original fair values determined at the time of business combination (date of acquisition); and
- (iii) The carrying amount of goodwill recognized under FRS is not adjusted.

#### (b) Property, plant and equipment

The Group has previously adopted the transitional provisions available on the first application of the MASB Approved Accounting Standard IAS 16 (Revised) Property, Plant and Equipment which was effective for periods ending on or after 1 September 1998. By virtue of this transitional provision, the Group had recorded certain buildings at revalued amounts but had not adopted a policy of revaluation and continued to carry those buildings on the basis of their previous revaluations subject to continuity in its depreciation policy and requirement to write down the assets to their recoverable amounts for impairment adjustments.

Upon transition to MFRS, the Group has elected to measure all its property, plant and equipment using the cost model under MFRS 116 Property, Plant and Equipment. At the date of transition to MFRS, the Group elected to:

• Regard the revalued amounts of buildings as at 1 July 1997 as deemed cost at the date of the revaluation as these amounts were broadly comparable to fair value at that date. The revaluation surplus RM101,000 (31 December 2011: RM101,000; 30 June 2012: RM101,000) was transferred to retained earnings on date of transition to MFRS.

### (c) Foreign currency translation reserve

Under FRS, the Group recognised translation differences on foreign operations in a separate component of equity. Cumulative foreign currency translation differences for all foreign operations are deemed to be zero as at the date of transition to MFRS. Accordingly, at date of transition to MFRS, the cumulative foreign currency translation differences of RM347,000 (31 December 2011: RM318,000; 30 June 2012: 259,000) were adjusted to retained earnings.

In the preparation of the Group's opening MFRS statements of financial positions, the amounts previously reported in accordance with FRS framework have been adjusted for the financial effects of the adoption of the MFRS framework. The Group posted revenue of RM211.782 million for the current financial period ended 31 December 2012, which is RM1.250 million or 0.59% higher than the corresponding period of the preceding year of RM210.532 million.

The shipping, marine services & others division recorded revenue of RM130.561 million which is RM7.694 million or 5.57% lower than the corresponding period of the preceding year of RM138.255 million. The decrease was mainly attributable to lower cargo volume. The profit before tax for the current period is RM6.654 million which is RM0.335 million lower than the corresponding period of the preceding year of RM6.989 million. The lower profit was mainly due to highly competitive operating environment putting pressure on earnings.

The logistics services and equipment rental division recorded revenue of RM92.728 million and profit before tax of RM13.972 million as compared to the previous corresponding period of the preceding year of RM53.794 million and RM7.973 million respectively. The performance of this division remains satisfactory.

The engineering contract division recorded a revenue of RM16.560 million and loss before tax of RM0.639 million as compared to the previous corresponding period of the preceding year of RM48.475 million and RM4.771 million respectively. The lower revenue which caused a marginal loss was mainly due to most of the major projects have been completed and newly secured projects are at the beginning stages.

The Group posted an increase in revenue of RM10.190 million or 10.11% in the current quarter ended 31 December 2012 of RM110.986 million as compared to RM100.796 million in the most recent preceding quarter ended 30 September 2012. The increase in the revenue is mainly from logistics services and equipment rental division.

The Group has registered a decrease in profit before taxation of RM8.836 million for the current quarter ended 31 December 2012 as compared to a profit before taxation of RM9.784 million in the most recent preceding quarter mainly from the engineering division due to reason mentioned in paragraph B1.

# B3. Prospects for the Current Financial Year

The Group expects stiff competition in the domestic and regional shipping industries due to oversupply of shipping spaces from various regional players. However, the logistics services, equipment rental and engineering divisions are expected to achieve a satisfactory result for the current financial year.
