1. Basis of Preparation

The interim financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

The interim financial statements are unaudited and have been prepared in accordance with the requirements of FRS 134: Interim Financial Reporting and paragraph 9.22 of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad.

The interim financial statements should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2005. These explanatory notes attached to the interim financial statements provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Company since the year ended 31 December 2005.

Items included in the financial statements of the Company's are measured using the currency of the primary economic environment in which the Company operates (the "functional currency"). The functional currency of the Company is Singapore Dollar. The financial statements are presented in Ringgit Malaysia, which is the Company's presentation currency.

Prior to 1 January 2006, such investments were classified as long term investments and were stated at cost less provision for diminution in value, with changes in carrying value recognised in profit or loss.

Prior to 1 January 2006, loans and receivables were stated at the gross proceeds receivable less provision for doubful debts.

(e) FRS 140: Investment Property

The adoption of this new FRS has resulted in a retrospective reclassification of the investment properties from property, plant and equipment. Investment properties are now stated at fair value, representing open-market value determined by external valuers. Gains or losses arising from changes in the fair values of investment properties are recognised in profit or loss in the period in which they arise. Prior to 1 January 2006, investment properties were stated at cost less accumulated depreciation. The Company's revenue of RM351,000 for the current quarter ended 31 December 2006 was lower than the corresponding quarter ended 31 December 2005, mainly due to lower dividend income partially offset by higher interest income. However, the year-to-date revenue of RM4.54 million was significantly higher than the RM3.663 million achieved during the corresponding year-to-date ended 31 December 2005, mainly due to higher dividend and interest income.

The after-tax profits for the current quarter of RM6.571 million and RM29.810 million for the current 12 months were significantly higher as compared to the corresponding quarter and 12 months ended 31 December 2005. These were mainly due to the early adoption of FRS 139 Financial Instruments: Recognition and Measurement as the Company revalued its long-term investment in securities, resulting in fair value gains of RM3.483 million and RM16.285 million for the current quarter and 12 months respectively. Share of associate's profit was RM2.965 million for the current quarter and RM10.755 million for the current financial period as compared to the profit of RM294,000 achieved during the corresponding quarter and the loss of RM573,000 suffered during the corresponding 12 months.

17. Comment on Material Change in Profit Before Taxation

The Company achieved a lower pre-tax profit of RM6.635 million for the current quarter ended 31 December 2006 as compared to the preceding quarter's profit of RM8.682 million mainly due to lower dividend income and fair value gain.

18. Commentary on Prospects

The Company's results for the rest of the financial year ending 30 June 2007 will be dependent on dividend income receivable from investments, the effect of exchange rate fluctuations and the market valuation of its investments. The results of the associated company may be further affected by the plantation contribution, which is not expected to improve due to lower production expected from older palms, replanting and recent floods which have affected the harvesting/evacuation of oil palm FFB works and the market valuation of its investments.

There is no profit forecast and profit guarantee.
