13. Performance Review

The Company's revenue of RM2.05 million for the current quarter and RM3.55 million for the current financial year were lower than last year's corresponding quarter and financial year by 26% and 10% respectively. These were mainly due to lower dividend and interest income.

For the current quarter, the Company's after-tax profit of RM6.07 million has dipped significantly from last year's corresponding quarter's RM17.63 million. This was due to the fair value gain from the revaluation of its long-term investment in securities was only RM160,000 as compared to last year's corresponding quarter's RM11.93 million. This was partially offset by higher share of associate's profit and higher fair value gain from the revaluation of the Company's investment properties.

The Company posted a net loss of RM4.97 million for the current financial year as compared to the net profit of RM69.05 million achieved a year ago despite the fair value gain of RM2.58 million arising from the revaluation of its investment properties was higher than last year's gain of RM1.51 million. This was due to:-

- 1) Lower dividend and interest income.
- 2) Revaluation of its long-term investment in securities was a fair value loss of RM19.99 million as compared to last year's fair value gain of RM48.11 million.
- 3) Share of associate's profit for the current financial year was RM10.27 million which was lower than last year's RM16.03 million.

14. Comment on Material Change in Profit Before Taxation for the Current Quarter as Compared with the Immediate Preceding Quarter

The Company achieved a pre-tax profit of RM6.08 million for the current quarter ended 30 June 2011 while was nearly 200% turnaround from the RM6.61 million pre-tax loss suffered during the immediate preceding quarter ended 31 March 2011. This was due to:-

- 1) Higher dividend income received.
- 2) Revaluation of its long-term investment in securities was a fair value gain of RM160,000 for the current quarter as compared to the fair value loss of RM5.04 million reported for the immediate preceding quarter.
- 3) Revaluation of its investment properties was a fair value gain of RM2.58 million while there was none for the immediate preceding quarter.
- 4) Share of associate's financial results was a profit of RM1.66 million for the current quarter while the immediate preceding quarter was a loss of RM1.52 million.

The Company's results for the next financial year ending 30 June 2012 will be dependent on dividend income receivable from investments, the effect of exchange rate fluctuations and the market valuation of its investments.

The results of the associated company may be affected by the plantation contribution and market valuation of its investments. The plantation is expected to perform satisfactorily as the prospects for the oil palm industry is expected to remain strong, supported by resilient demand from the food sector, price competitiveness over the other edible oils and higher consumption in emerging markets. The production may however be affected by the proposed compulsory land acquisition by the State Government of 25 hectare for workers' housing scheme.
