#### 16. Performance Review

The Company's revenue of RM261,000 for the current quarter and RM1.57 million for the period-to-date ended 31 March 2013 were higher than last year's corresponding quarter of RM213,000 and period-to-date of RM1.50 million. This was mainly due to the exchange difference arising from the conversion of the revenue in SGD functional currency to RM reporting currency. In term of the functional currency, current quarter's dividend income was at same level of the quarter a year ago while current period-to-date's was lower. Interest income for the current quarter and period to-date were higher than a year ago while rental income remained the same level as last year's corresponding quarter and period-to-date.

For the current quarter, the Company achieved an after-tax profit of RM21.27 million which was significantly higher than corresponding quarter a year ago by RM3.84 million despite share of associate's profit of RM3.83 million was lower than last year's corresponding quarter of RM7.57 million. This was due to higher fair value gain from the revaluation of its long-term investment in securities by RM7.57 million.

For the 9 months to-date, the Company achieved an after-tax profit of RM52.63 million which is a positive turnaround from the loss of RM7.56 million suffered a year ago. This was due to:-

- 1) The revaluation of its long-term investment in securities for the current period-to-date was a fair value gain of RM39.64 million as compared to the fair value loss of RM6.37 million reported a year ago.
- 2) Share of associate's financial results was a profit of RM12.28 million while last year's corresponding period-to-date was a loss of RM2.01 million.

# 17. Comment on Material Change in Profit Before Taxation for the Current Quarter as Compared with the Immediate Preceding Quarter

The Company posted a pre-tax profit of RM21.28 million for the current quarter ended 31 March 2013 which was better than the immediate preceding quarter's RM6.13 million despite lower revenue. This was due to:-

- 1) The fair value gain of RM17.47 million arising from the revaluation of its long-term investment in securities for the current quarter ended 31 March 2013 was higher than the gain of RM4.09 million reported for the immediate preceding quarter ended 31 December 2012.
- 2) Share of associate's profit of RM3.83 million was higher than the immediate preceding quarter's profit of RM1.96 million.

The plantation is not expected to perform better than the last financial year due to the Government's implementation of minimum wage policy, low fresh fruit bunches production and CPO prices are expected to remain bearish.
