On 19 November 2011, the Malaysian Accounting Standards Board ("MASB") issued a new MASB approved accounting framework, the MFRS. The MFRS is to be applied by all Entities Other Than Private Entities for annual periods beginning on or after 1 January 2012, with the exception of entities subject to the application of MFRS 141 Agriculture ("MFRS 141") and IC Interpretation 15 Instruments Agreements for Construction of Real Estate ("IC 15"), including its parent, significant investor and venture (here in referred to as "Transitioning Entities"). Transitioning Entities will be allowed to defer adoption of the new MFRS for an additional one year.

On 7 August 2013, MASB announced that the Transitioning Entities are allowed to extend their deferment on the adoption of MFRS Framework for another year. As such, the MFRS Framework will be mandatory for all companies for annual period beginning on or after 1 January 2015.

The Group falls within the definition of Transitioning Entities and has opted to defer adoption of the new MFRS to 1 January 2015. Accordingly, the Group will be required to prepare its first MFRS financial statements for the year ending 31 March 2016. In presenting its first MFRS financial statements, the Group will quantify the financial effects of the differences between the current FRS and MFRS. The majority of the adjustments required on transition will be made, retrospectively, against opening retained earnings.

Accordingly, the consolidated financial performance and financial position as disclosed in these financial statements for the period to-date ended 31 December 2013 could be different if prepared under the MFRS.

The Group's preceding annual financial statements were reported without any qualification.

The business operations of the Group are generally not affected by seasonal or cyclical factors except for the hotel operations which are generally affected by major festive seasons.

# B1. Review of Performance of the Company and its Principal Subsidiaries

For the current quarter ended 31 December 2013, the Group achieved a higher turnover of RM119.64 million and net profit of RM14.65 million compared to RM82.19 million and RM9.28 million respectively in the corresponding quarter last year.

For the 9 months to-date, the Group achieved a higher turnover of RM275.79 million and net profit of RM33.41 million compared to RM209.23 million and RM30.11 million respectively in the corresponding period to-date last year.

The higher turnover and net profit was mainly attributable to higher revenue and profit recognition from Dedaun, Hijauan, By The Sea and Village projects compared to the previous corresponding quarter.

# **B2.** Material Changes in Profit Before Tax of the Current Quarter compared to the Immediate Preceding Quarter

For the quarter ended 31 December 2013, the Group registered a higher profit before tax of RM20.89 million compared to RM11.59 million recorded in the preceding quarter ended 30 September 2013. The higher pre-tax profit was mainly due to better sales and work progress of Dedaun, Hijauan, By The Sea and Village projects.

# B3. Prospects for the Current Financial Year

With the stringent guidelines on loan application issued by the Bank Negara and providing additional / transparent disclosures of sales packages, the Group expects these measures to soften demand in the Malaysian real property market in the first half of this year as potential buyers and investors will find it more difficult to obtain loan.

Nevertheless, the Group expects the property market would be able to absorb and re-strategize upon these elements mentioned above, and that demand for property would return in earnest from the second half of 2014.

With unbilled sales of approximately RM956 million in hand, the Group expects performance for the rest of the current financial year to remain satisfactory.
