Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards ("MFRS")

On 19 November 2011, the Malaysian Accounting Standards Board ("MASB") issued a new MASB approved accounting framework, the MFRS. The MFRS is to be applied by all Entities Other Than Private Entities for annual periods beginning on or after 1 January 2012, with the exception of entities subject to the application of MFRS 141 Agriculture ("MFRS 141") and IC Interpretation 15 Instruments Agreements for Construction of Real Estate ("IC 15"), including its parent, significant investor and venture (here in referred to as "Transitioning Entities"). Transitioning Entities will be allowed to defer adoption of the new MFRS for an additional one year.

On 2 September 2014, MASB further announced that the Transitioning Entities are allowed to extend their deferment on the adoption of MFRS Framework for another year. As such, the MFRS Framework will be mandatory for all companies for annual period beginning on or after 1 January 2017.

The Group falls within the definition of Transitioning Entities and has opted to defer adoption of the new MFRS to 1 January 2017. Accordingly, the Group will be required to prepare its first MFRS financial statements for the year ending 31 March 2018. In presenting its first MFRS financial statements, the Group will quantify the financial effects of the differences between the current FRS and MFRS. The majority of the adjustments required on transition will be made, retrospectively, against opening retained earnings.

Accordingly, the consolidated financial performance and financial position as disclosed in these financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2014 could be different if prepared under the MFRS.

Audit Report of Preceding Annual Financial Statements A2.

The Group's preceding annual financial statements were reported without any qualification.

B1. Review of Performance of the Company and its Principal Subsidiaries

For the 9 months ended 31 December 2014, the Group achieved a higher turnover of RM296.12 million compared to the corresponding period to-date last year and a lower net profit of RM31.03 million. The higher turnover was mainly attributable to better work progress over the 9 months period in Windows On The Park and By The Sea compared to the corresponding period of last financial year. Net profit was slightly lower mainly due to impact from slowdown in tourism industry which has adversely affected the hotel business.

B2. Material Changes in Profit Before Tax of the Current Quarter compared to the Immediate Preceding Quarter

For the quarter ended 31 December 2014, the Group registered a lower profit before tax of RM11.93 million compared to RM15.36 million recorded in the preceding quarter ended 30 September 2014. Comparatively, the lower profit was mainly due to slower sales for the current quarter as the property market is experiencing the effect of cooling measures implemented and the pending implementation of GST (Goods and Service Tax) by the government.

B3. Prospects for the Current Financial Year

The outlook for coming year is expected to remain challenging in view of stringent bank loan guidelines and pending implementation of GST.

The Group expects the above mentioned factors will soften the demand in the Malaysian real property market for the remaining of this financial year as potential buyers and investors rethink their next purchase and investment. However, with unbilled sales of approximately RM783 million in hand, the Group expects the current financial year performance to be satisfactory.
