1. Review of Performance

Due to the change in the financial year end as stated in Note 8, no comparable figures are presented.

(a) Overall Results Commentary:

For the current quarter

The Group recorded a revenue of RM5.30 million. Revenue contribution from construction and property investment and management stood at RM3.55 million and RM1.66 million respectively.

Group pre-tax profit was RM0.64 million. The profitability was impacted by a recovery of previously impaired receivables amounting to RM3.12 million and a reversal of impairment of inventories of RM7.69 million during the current quarter. The impairment of inventories was reversed as the result of an approval by the relevant authorities to convert some land from residential to industrial, thereby significantly enhancing the value of the property.

The profitability of the current quarter was mitigated by a higher depreciation charge of RM0.93 million that arose from the reclassification of the assets of the Hotel and Recreation Division from "Assets Held For Sale" to "Investment Properties" as reported under Schedule E, Note 9.

For the current year-to-date

The Group recorded a revenue of RM16.54 million. Revenue contribution from construction and property investment and management stood at RM9.23 million and RM5.08 million respectively.

Group pre-tax profit of RM31.17 million included a net gain of RM33.4 million that arose from the Global Settlement Agreement with WCE Holdings Bhd. together with the RM12.2 million debts waived as disclosed in previous quarterly reports. In the current quarter, the group's results were enhanced by the reversal of impairment of receivables and inventories as explained above. At the same time, profitability was adversely impacted by a higher depreciation charge of RM2.73 million that came about from the reclassification of the assets of the Hotel and Recreation Division.

(b) Segmental Results Commentary:

(i) Property Development Division

For the current quarter

The division recorded a revenue of RM0.09 million with pre-tax profit of RM2.40 million.

The higher pre-tax profit was mainly due to the same explanations as presented in Schedule F Note 1 (a) above.

The division recorded a revenue of RM2.23 million with pre-tax profit of RM35.58 million.

(ii) Property Investment and Management Division

For the current quarter

The division recorded a revenue of RM1.66 million with pre-tax loss of RM1.92 million.

There was an additional RM0.93 million of depreciation charge on the hotel assets due to the reclassification of the hotel assets from "Assets Held For Sale" to Investment Properties. At the same time, there were savings from lower land use and property tax from a partial tax exemption granted by the China tax authority effective from April 2019 onwards.

6. Status of Corporate Proposals

On 22 March 2019, the Company announced the proposal to undertake a private placement of up to 10% of the total number of issued shares at a proposed issue price of RM0.045 per placement share. 8. Material Litigation

Save as disclosed below, neither the Group nor the Company are engaged in any material litigation, claims or arbitration either as plaintiff or defendant, which has a material effect on the business or financial position of the Group, and the Board of Directors has no knowledge of any proceedings pending or threatened against the Group or of any fact likely to give rise to any proceedings which might materially and adversely affect the business or financial position of the Group:

A Writ of Summons and the Statement of Claim was filed in the Kuala Lumpur High Court by Universal Healthcare (R&D) Sdn Bhd ("UHSB") against TTB and 3 other Defendants who were Directors of Pandan Indah Medical Management Sdn. Bhd. (In Liquidation), a former subsidiary of TTB ("PIMM").

UHSB claims against TTB for the Declarations that TTB is a director of PIMM and that the business of PIMM was carried out by its Directors and/ or TTB and that the Directors of PIMM and/or TTB are personally liable to UHSB. Consequently, UHSB is seeking an order that the Directors of PIMM and/ or TTB pay jointly and/ or severally, the alleged debt arising from the judgment sum of RM23.82 million assessed by UHSB against PIMM together with interest at the rate of 8% per annum from the date of Writ of Summons until full settlement amounting to a total alleged claim of RM49.23 million (as at 12 October 2015) and/ or in the alternative, damages to be assessed.

TTB has filed its Defence and also counterclaimed against UHSB and the 3 Directors of UHSB for general damages, exemplary damages and aggravated damages for the tort of abuse of process and/ or malicious prosecution.

The full trial of the Civil Suit commenced on 19, 23 and 24 January 2017 and continued to be partly heard on 19 and 20 June 2017, 1, 2 and 3 August 2017, 20 and 24 October 2017 and 27 and 28 November 2017. The Court further continued with the hearing on 18, 19 and 29 January 2018 and 9 and 12 February 2018 and 15 March 2018 and 5, 7, & 8 June 2018 for continued hearing and completed the full hearing on 25 June 2018. Both parties have put in their written submission on 20 August 2018 and the reply on 12 September 2018. The Court had on 10 January 2019 and 12th to 14th June 2019 heard oral submissions and the Court has fixed 29 August 2019 to deliver its decision and was then deferred to 29 January 2020 for decision.

Based on our legal counsel's advice, this Civil Suit by UHSB is unlikely to succeed.
