# **16.** Performance Review

The Group's revenue for the current quarter of RM2.14 million and period-to-date of RM3.75 million were lower than the corresponding quarter and period-to-date ended 31 December 2011 by RM150,000 and RM425,000 respectively despite higher dividend and interest income. These shortfalls were due to lower crop sales arising from lower FFB prices although fresh fruit bunches productions were higher for the fiscal first half year.

For the current quarter and 6 months to-date, the Group's after-tax profit of RM1.90 million and RM5.0 million were improvements from last year's corresponding quarter's RM905,000 and period-to-date's RM571,000. These were due to:-

- 1) The unrealised exchange difference for the current quarter and period-to-date were gains of RM30,000 and RM455,000 respectively while losses of RM55,000 and RM797,000 were recorded for last year's corresponding quarter and period-to-date respectively.
- 2) Share of associates' financial results was a profit of RM829,000 for the current quarter and RM3.15 million for the period-to-date while the corresponding quarter and period-to-date a year ago were losses of RM293,000 and RM443,000 respectively.

# **17.** Comment on Material Change in Profit Before Taxation for the Current Quarter as Compared with the Immediate Preceding Quarter

For the quarter under review, the Group's revenue of RM2.14 million was higher than the immediate preceding quarter's RM1.61 million despite lower crop sales. This was due to the dividend income of RM791,000 received during the current quarter while there was none during the immediate preceding quarter.

The Group reported a pre-tax profit of RM2.03 million for the current quarter which was lower than the immediate preceding quarter's RM3.24 million despite higher revenue. This was mainly due to:-

- 1) The unrealised foreign exchange gain of RM30,000 for the current quarter was lower than the immediate preceding quarter's RM425,000.
- 2) Share of profit of associates for the current quarter was only RM829,000 as compared to the immediate preceding quarter's RM2.32 million.

# 18. Commentary on Prospects

The performance for the rest of the financial year is expected not to be better than last year due to the following reasons:-

- 1) The yield of fresh fruit bunches are normally expected to be low between February to May.
- 2) The labour cost is expected to increase as the Government has implemented the minimum wage policy with effect from January 2013.
- 3) Demand for palm oil worldwide has been slow and therefore CPO prices are expected to remain low.

The results of the associated companies may be further affected by the market valuation of their investments and currency fluctuations.
