Quarterly Report 30th September 2007

1. Accounting Policies

The interim financial report has been prepared in accordance with the reporting requirements as set out in the Financial Reporting Standards ("FRS") No. 134 – "Interim Financial Reporting" and Paragraph 9.22 of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad and should be read in conjunction with the Group's annual audited financial statements for the year ended 31st December 2006.

The significant accounting policies and methods of computation adopted in the interim financial statements are consistent with those of the annual financial statements for the year ended 31st December 2006 except for the adoption of the new/revised FRS effective for financial period beginning 1 January 2007:

FRS 117 Leases

Prior to 1 Jan 2007, leasehold land was classified as property, plant and equipment and was stated at cost less accumulated depreciation. The adoption of FRS 117 has resulted in a retrospective change in the accounting policy relating to the classification of leasehold land which is now classified as an operating lease. The up-front payments made for the leasehold land represents prepaid lease payments and continue to be amortised on a straight-line basis over the lease term. The reclassification of leasehold land as prepaid lease payments has no impact on the income statements.

2. Qualification of Preceding Annual Financial Statements

The audit report of the most recent annual financial statements for the year ended 31st December 2006 was not qualified.

3. Seasonal or Cyclical Factors

The business operations of the Group were not materially affected by any seasonal or cyclical factors during the quarter under review.

4. Unusual Items

There was no unusual item affecting assets, liabilities, equity, net income, or cash flows during the quarter.

5. Material Changes In Estimates

There were no material changes in estimates from either the prior interim period or prior financial years that have a material effect in the current quarter results.

6. Debts and Equity Securities

There were no issuances, cancellation, repurchases, resale and repayments of debts and equity securities during the financial period under review.

7. Dividend Paid

A 2nd interim dividend of 15 sen per share less 27% tax and a special tax exempt dividend of 15 sen per share were paid out on 11th September 2007.



8. Segmental Reporting

No segmental analysis is prepared as the Group is primarily engaged in the manufacturing and sales of tobacco products in Malaysia.

9. Valuation of Property, Plant and Equipment

There were no valuations of property, plant and equipment during the financial period under review or being brought forward from the previous Annual Financial Statements.

10. Material Events Subsequent To The End of The Period

There are no material events subsequent to the end of the period reported which have not been reflected in the financial period.

11. Changes In The Composition of The Group

There were no changes in the composition of the Group during the quarter under review.

12. Contingent Liabilities and Contingent Assets

There were no changes in contingent liabilities or contingent assets since the last annual balance sheet as at 31st December 2006.

14. Review of Performance

For the quarter under review, the Group registered revenues of RM 234.6 million as compared with RM 224.0 million in the same period last year. Profit before tax in the current quarter was lower at RM 37.7 million as compared with RM 43.8 million in the same period last year. The increase in revenues was driven by higher cigarette prices offset partially by lower sales volume. Profit before tax was lower mainly attributable to higher marketing and operating expenditures.

For the cumulative period to 30th September 2007, the Group achieved revenues of RM 647.5 million and profit before tax of RM 105.4 million as compared with revenues of RM 612.3 million and profit before tax of RM 103.4 million for the corresponding period last year. The increase in both revenues and profit before tax was mainly driven by higher cigarette prices offset by lower sales volumes, higher marketing and operating expenditures.

15. Comparison With Preceding Quarter's Result

For the quarter under review, the Group registered revenues of RM 234.6 million and a profit before tax of RM 37.7 million as compared to the preceding quarter's revenues of RM 205.0 million and profit before tax of RM29.5 million. The increase in both revenues and profit before tax was mainly attributed to the excise driven price increase in July 2007.



16. Prospects for This Financial Year

The industry saw a further decline in overall sales volume for the period under review, largely due to increasing levels of illegal cigarettes, together with the continued growth of exceptionally low priced cigarettes. JTI remains concerned that the impact of the tax-led price increase in July will further fuel the growth of illegal cigarettes. These illicit cigarette products continue to undermine the Government's revenue collection and health policies. In this regard, JTI will cooperate fully with the authorities to address the issue of illegal cigarettes.

The Group expects market conditions to remain challenging for the final quarter of 2007, as the continuing industry volume decline is further exacerbated by consumers down-trading to either illegal or exceptionally low priced cigarettes. However, JTI is committed to maintaining its competitiveness and delivering a satisfactory overall performance for the current financial year through continued effective investment behind its key brands – Winston, Salem, Mild Seven and Camel.

17. Profit Forecast or Guarantee

There was no profit forecast or profit guarantee made during the financial period under review.
