A. EXPLANATORY NOTES PURSUANT TO MFRS 134 - INTERIM FINANCIAL REPORTING

A1. Basis of preparation

The interim financial report is unaudited and has been prepared in accordance with the requirements of MFRS 134: Interim Financial Reporting and Chapter 9.22 of the Listing Requirements of the Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad ("BMSB").

The interim financial report should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements of the Group for the year ended 31 December 2017. These explanatory notes attached to the interim financial report provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group since the financial year ended 31 December 2017.

B. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION REQUIRED BY BURSA MALAYSIA LISTING REQUIREMENTS

B1. Review of Performance

During the quarter under review, the Group recorded a consolidated revenue of RM238.8 million compared to the corresponding quarter of the preceding year of RM269.3 million. Such reduction in revenue during the current quarter under review was due to lower average selling price of the metallurgical coke despite a higher sale volume. The average selling price of metallurgical coke has declined by approximately 8% to RMB1,889 during this current quarter from RMB2,043 in the preceding year corresponding quarter. The sales volume however, was only marginally higher by approximately 4% in the third quarter of 2018 compared to previous year corresponding quarter. On the other hand, the overall contribution from the by-products has increased by approximately 25% during the current quarter compared to that of the preceding quarter. This was primarily attributed to the increase in the prices of ammonium sulphate, tar oil and coal gas of 15%, 18% and 31% respectively. However, such improvements seen in the contribution from the by-products in itself, which accounted for approximately 16% of the total revenue, was insufficient to negate the effects of the decline in the selling price of the main product i.e. metallurgical coke.

The Group recorded a cost of sales amounting to approximately RM225.1 million during the current quarter under review compared to approximately RM227.4 million in the previous year corresponding quarter. The average coal price has increased by approximately 5% from RMB1,263 per tonne in the current quarter compared to RMB 1,198 per tonne in the previous year corresponding quarter. With such pricing dynamics of the metallurgical coke and coal, the Group recorded a lower gross profit of approximately RM13.8 million in the current quarter under review compared to approximately RM41.9 million in the preceding year corresponding quarter.

Other income was higher during the quarter under review was due to higher sales of scraps and penalty imposed on the workers who violated the company's rules as compared to the preceding year corresponding quarter.

Operating expenses incurred by the Group were slightly lower at approximately RM7.3 million in the current quarter under review compared to approximately RM8.0 million in the same quarter last year. Operating expense includes staff salary, depreciation, minor repair and maintenance, electricity and etc.

As a result thereof, the Group recorded a net profit before tax of approximately RM6.7 million in the current quarter under review compared to approximately RM34.0 million in the preceding year corresponding quarter.

B2. Variation of results against preceding quarter

The consolidated revenue registered by the Group during the quarter under review was slightly lower at approximately RM238.8 million compared to RM240.3 million recorded during the immediate preceding quarter ended 30 June 2018. This was primarily attributed to the effects of the exchange rate (whereby the Chinese yuan was seen to have had devalued approximately 1.1% against the Malaysian Ringgit based on the respective 3-month average comparative periods) despite slightly higher average coke price of approximately RMB1,889 per tonne during the current quarter under review

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compared to RMB1,836 per tonne recorded during the last quarter ended 30 June 2018. The sales volume had also increased by approximately 7% in comparison.

The cost of sales recorded by the Group during the quarter under review was approximately RM225.1 million as compared to RM233.6 million during the immediate preceding quarter ended 30 June 2018. This was again attributed to the effect of the exchange rate (as stated above), despite of the slight increase in sale volume and the average coal price. The average coal price stood at approximately RMB1,263 per tonne during the quarter under review compared to approximately RMB1,239 per tonne during immediate preceding quarter. The Group recorded a gross profit of approximately RM13.8 million in the current quarter under review compared to approximately RM6.7 million in the immediate preceding quarter ended 30 June 2018.

The Group recorded higher operating expenses of approximately RM7.3 million during the quarter under review compared to RM4.1 million in the immediate preceding quarter ended 30 June 2018. The relatively higher operating expenses in the current quarter mainly attributed to the payment of property and land tax, of which were not incurred in the immediate preceding quarter.

After taking into consideration of other income and operating expenses, the Group recorded a net profit of approximately RM6.7 million during the quarter under review as compared to approximately RM2.5 million in the immediate preceding quarter ended 31 June 2018.

B3. Current year prospects

China's growth seems to continue to slow down as evidenced in its third quarter economic growth of 6.5%, being the weakest pace since the global financial crisis. This was primarily precipitated by the trade war with the United States. The expected slowdown in the China's domestic economy, the geo-political risk resulting from the current trade war, the continuous enhancements and strict enforcements of the local environmental protection policies will continue to affect the steel and coke industry. Moreover, moving into winter when the focus is given to the supply of thermal coal for heat generation purpose, the production and supply of the coking coal would be limited and is expected to result in more price pressures from the coking coal. The China's environmental protection policy is expected to continue to cause some imbalance to the short-term supply and demand of steel and coke industry, which may inherently result in further price volatility in the months to come.

In summary, due to the various external and domestic headwinds mentioned above, the upside trend of the coke market is expected to taper off for the rest of the year, if not extended over a protracted period of time into the future.

Notwithstanding the above, the Group remained cautiously optimistic in the coke industry moving forward and will continue to be vigilant to relevant consequential circumstances that may have perceivable effect on the metallurgical coke business, to which necessary action steps will be taken to face those challenges as and when they arise.

B4. Variation on Forecast Profit / Profit Guarantee

The Group did not issue any profit forecast nor profit guarantee during the current financial period to date.

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B5. Taxation

No taxation was provided during the quarter under review.
