B1. Review of Performance of the Company and its Principal Subsidiaries

For the quarter and year-to-date

With the continual progress of construction from its 8trium project as sales reached 83% and also efforts from its education sector to maintain their existing results amidst rising costs, the Group posted an operating profit before tax of RM3.0 million for the quarter compared to the corresponding quarter of the preceding year of RM0.4 million.

However, compared to a pre-tax profit of RM1.6 million against a revenue of RM6.0 million in the corresponding quarter of the preceding year and preceding year-to-date, the Group recorded a pre-tax loss of RM1.4 million on the back of a revenue of RM11.9 million for the quarter and year-to-date under review due to the following:-

- The fair value loss of RM3.4 million on its quoted investments,
- The share of loss of RM0.9 million attributed from the Group's jointly controlled entities arising from further delays experienced from its development of bungalow lots in Australia;
 and
- A one-off provision for compensation claim of RM0.5 million.

B2. Material Changes in the Quarterly Results Compared to the Results of the Preceding Quarter

For the current quarter under review, the Group's pre-tax loss was RM1.4 million compared the immediate preceding quarter's pre-tax loss of RM1.5 million. There was no significant change in operational results from that of the immediate preceding quarter. Fair value loss and loss posted by its jointly controlled entity in Australia remained around RM3.4 million and RM1.0 million respectively.

B3. Prospects

Despite the concerns in the financial markets following the sovereign-debts crisis of developed countries and the increasing construction costs in the recent years, the Group expects its performance for the financial year ending 31 March 2012 to be satisfactory with the contribution from 8trium project, which is expected to be completed by early 2012 and also the additional profit to be recognized arising from its joint venture project "The Elements" in Ampang.

B13. Material Litigations

(a) Las Maha Corporation Sdn Bhd ("Las Maha") entered into a contract with Sri Damansara Sdn Bhd ("SDSB"), a wholly owned subsidiary of the Company, on 21 January 2000 to carry out construction and completion of building and relevant infrastructure works of the development project in Bandar Sri Damansara for a contract sum of RM11.5 million. Due to late delivery of the project SDSB has imposed liquidated damages on Las Maha for late completion of the project.

On 2 April 2004, Las Maha sent a Notice of Arbitration to SDSB alleging, inter alia, that SDSB was not entitled for any damages for late completion of the project as Las Maha had achieved Practical Completion of works within reasonable time. In view of this SDSB has decided to refer the matter to Arbitration. Las Maha is claiming for the sum of RM2.2 million and SDSB has submitted a counter-claim for the amount of RM4.8 million, being liquidated damages claim of RM2.8 million and other claims totalling RM2.0 million.

SDSB was subsequently informed by its solicitors that Las Maha has been wound up on 15 February 2005. SDSB's solicitors have filed the proof of debt on 20 February 2006. The Provisional Liquidator has yet to call for a Creditors Meeting.

(b) A claim of RM6.7 million was made against Navistar Sdn Bhd ("Navistar"), a wholly owned subsidiary of the Company, by AK2 Runding Sdn Bhd ("AK2"). The claim is for purported fees due and outstanding for unpaid balance of professional fees for architectural consultancy services rendered for a proposed three stage commercial development then undertaken by Navistar.

AK2 served the Writ of summons dated 20 August 2008 on Navistar and Navistar had responded. The matter is fixed for next case management on 17 October 2011.

Apart from the above, the Directors are not aware of any other proceedings pending against the Company and/or its subsidiaries or of any facts likely to give rise to any proceedings which may materially affect the position of the Company and/or its subsidiaries.

B14. Dividend

The Board does not recommend a dividend payment for the financial period under review.
