1 Corporate information

George Kent (Malaysia) Berhad is a public limited liability company incorporated and domiciled in Malaysia, and is listed on Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad ("Bursa").

These condensed consolidated interim financial statements were approved by the Board of Directors on 19 March 2018.

2 Basis of preparation

These condensed consolidated interim financial statements, for the year ended 31 January 2018, have been prepared in accordance with Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards ("MFRS") 134 Interim Financial Reporting and Paragraph 9.22 of the Listing Requirements of Bursa. These condensed consolidated interim financial statements also comply with IAS 34 Interim Financial Reporting issued by the International Accounting Standard Board and should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements of the Group for the financial year ended 31 January 2017.

The consolidated financial statements of the Group for the financial year ended 31 January 2017 are available upon request from the Company's registered office at 1115, Jalan Puchong, Taman Meranti Jaya, 47120 Puchong, Selangor Darul Ehsan.

The explanatory notes attached to these condensed consolidated interim financial statements provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group since the financial year ended 31 January 2017.

3 Significant accounting policies

The significant accounting policies adopted are consistent with those of the audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 January 2017, except for the adoption of the following amendments to MFRSs:

Effective for financial periods beginning on or after 1 January 2017

- Amendments to MFRS 107: Disclosure Initiative
- Amendments to MFRS 112: Recognition of Deferred Tax Assets for Unrealised Losses
- Amendments to MFRSs: Annual Improvements to MFRSs 2014 2016 Cycle

The Directors expect that the adoption of the above Amendments to MFRSs will not result in any significant changes in the accounting policies and will not have any significant effect on the financial position, results and disclosures in the financial statements of the Group and the Company in the period of initial application.

4 Changes in estimates

There were no changes in estimates that have had a material effect in the current interim results.

5 Changes in composition of the Group

There were no significant changes in the composition of the Group during the current interim period.



6 Segment information

Segment information is presented in respect of the Group's operating segments. The activities within each of these segments are explained below:

(a) Engineering

Engineering comprises mainly revenue derived from the execution of construction contracts and income derived from infrastructure.

(b) Metering

Metering comprises mainly revenue derived from the production, marketing and trading of water related product and services.

There has been no material change in total assets and no differences in the basis of segmentation or in the basis of measurement of segment profit or loss as compared to the last annual financial statements.

6 Segment information (continued)

Engineering

Revenue of RM139.63 million for the current quarter ended 31 January 2018 was 10% lower as compared to RM155.21 million for the corresponding quarter in 2017. Segment profit of RM73.98 million for the current quarter ended 31 January 2018 was 50% higher as compared to RM49.26 million for the corresponding quarter in 2017. Construction accounts for 96% of the revenue and 98% of segment profit of the Engineering Division. The higher segment profit was mainly contributed by the improvement in profit margin of a project and higher share of results of joint venture.

Revenue of RM464.60 million for the year ended 31 January 2018 was marginally lower as compared to RM471.46 million for the corresponding period in 2017. Segment profit of RM154.48 million for the year ended 31 January 2018 was 34% higher as compared to RM115.33 million for the year ended 31 January 2017 due to the higher segment profit margin and higher share of results of joint venture.

Metering

Revenue of RM33.28 million for the current quarter ended 31 January 2018 was marginally lower compared to RM33.93 million for the corresponding quarter in 2017. Segment profit of RM5.50 million for the current quarter ended 31 January 2018 was 32% lower as compared to RM8.07 million for the corresponding quarter in 2017, due to lower gross profit margin and higher operating expenses.

Revenue of RM152.39 million for the year ended 31 January 2018 was 20% higher compared to RM127.51 million for the corresponding period in 2017. Segment profit of RM36.21 million for the year ended 31 January 2018 was 32% higher as compared to RM27.33 million for the corresponding period in 2017 mainly due to the higher revenue and gross profit margin in the current period derived from local sales of water meters, particularly to local authority in Johor and Selangor.

Consolidated revenue

The Group mainly derives its revenue from Malaysia, other ASEAN countries, Hong Kong and Papua New Guinea. Its core businesses are centred in the water industry and engineering works. The main factors which have affected the Group's revenue have been stated above.

Consolidated profit before tax

The Group's current quarter profit before tax of RM65.57 million (31 January 2017: RM57.88 million) was 13% higher. The higher profit before tax reported was in line with the higher profit contributed by the Engineering division. Other losses mainly arose from unrealised loss on foreign exchange of RM9.48 million (31 January 2017: unrealised gain of RM1.85 million) on foreign currencies held.

The Group's profit before tax for the year ended 31 January 2018 of RM160.33 million (31 January 2017: RM134.10 million) was 20% higher. The higher profit before tax reported was in line with the higher profits contributed by both the Engineering and Metering divisions. Other losses mainly arose from unrealised loss on foreign exchange of RM12.00 million (31 January 2017: unrealised gain of RM4.38 million) on foreign currencies held.

7 Seasonality of operations

The Group's performance was not affected by any significant seasonal or cyclical factors.

Domestic income tax is calculated at the Malaysian statutory rate of 24% of the estimated assessable profit. Taxation for other jurisdictions is calculated at the rates prevailing in the respective jurisdictions.

The effective tax rate was lower than the statutory tax rate mainly due to the effect of share of results of associate and joint venture, which were presented net of tax.



10 Earnings Per Share

Basic earnings per share amounts are calculated by dividing profit for the period, net of tax attributable to owners by the number of ordinary shares outstanding during the period.

Diluted earnings per share amounts are calculated by dividing profit for the period, net of tax attributable to owners by the weighted average number of ordinary shares outstanding during the period, plus the weighted average number of ordinary shares that would be issued on the conversion of the dilutive potential ordinary shares into ordinary shares.

Computer software

Computer software are stated at cost less any accumulated impairment losses and are amortised on a straight-line basis over the estimated economic useful lives at the annual rate of 20%. The amortisation of computer software is recognised in profit or loss.

Product development costs

Product development costs relate to costs incurred in the development of new products, considered to have finite useful lives, are stated at cost less any accumulated impairment losses and are amortised over the period of expected benefit not exceeding 10 years on straight-line basis. The amortisation of product development costs is recognised in profit or loss.

Other development costs

Other development costs considered to have finite useful lives, are stated at cost less any accumulated impairment losses and are amortised using the straight-line basis from the commencement of the contract to which they relate over the period of their expected benefit not exceeding 20 years. The amortisation of other development costs is recognised in profit or loss.

20 Dividends

The Directors have declared a third interim dividend of 5.0 sen per share (FY2017: final dividend of 5.0 sen per share) on the enlarged 563.27 million shares (FY2017: 375.51 million shares) amounting to RM28.16 million (FY2017: RM18.78 million) up 50% for the financial year ended 31 January 2018. The dividend will be paid on 25 April 2018 to shareholders whose names appear in the Record of Depositors on 5 April 2018.

Two interim dividends have been paid for the financial year ended 31 January 2018. In Ringgit term, the total dividend for the financial year ended 31 January 2018 will be RM53.51 million (FY2017: RM37.56 million), up by 43%.

The profit before taxation for the current quarter ended 31 January 2018 is 79% higher than the preceding quarter due to higher profit contributed by both the Engineering and Metering divisions.

27 Commentary on prospects

The Group capped off the last quarter with a record profit before tax of RM65.57 million (31 January 2017: RM57.88 million) and profit after tax of RM51.88 million (31 January 2017: RM42.02 million) on the back of a revenue of RM172.91 million (31 January 2017: RM189.14 million). The higher earnings is derived from the improved performance of the Engineering division.

The Engineering division's improved performance was derived from on-going, completed as well as new projects secured in the previous year. The Metering division's lower earnings was contributed by lower gross profit margin and higher operating expenses.

For the twelve-months period, the profit before tax and profit after tax of RM160.33 million (31 January 2017: RM134.10 million) and RM124.43 million (31 January 2017: RM101.28 million) respectively was another record on the back of a record twelve-months revenue of RM616.99 million (31 January 2017: RM598.97 million). With the smooth execution of the on-going projects, barring unforeseen circumstances, the Group anticipates another year of good performance. With an already strong order book of RM5.6 billion, we are continuing to assess new opportunities in both the Engineering and Metering sectors.
