#### 1. Accounting Policies

The interim financial report has been prepared in accordance with the requirements of Financial Reporting Standards ("FRS") 134 "Interim Financial Reporting" issued by the Malaysian Accounting Standards Board (MASB) and paragraph 9.22 of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad. It should be read in conjunction with the Group's annual audited financial statements for the year ended 30 June 2008.

The accounting policies and methods of computation adopted by the Group for this interim financial report are consistent with those adopted in the financial statements for the year ended 30 June 2008.

All Related Party Transactions had been entered into in the ordinary course of business on normal commercial terms. These transactions are within the ambit of the general mandate approved by the shareholders of the Company on 26 November 2008.

#### 15. Review of Performance

Current 9 months results against same 9 months period of the last financial year

Group revenue for the 9 months ended 31 March 2009 grew 6.9% to RM1,009.1 million from RM944.3 million in the corresponding period in the previous fiscal year.

Group profit before tax increased by 6.6% or RM9.5 million to RM153.2 million.

#### Comparison of Third Quarter against Corresponding Quarter 2008

Group revenue for the third quarter ended 31 March 2009 declined by RM13.9 million as compared to the corresponding quarter in 2008. The 4.2% drop was mainly due to the difference in timing of Chinese New Year.

Group profit before tax for the same period was lower at RM43.6 million compared to RM49.1 million in the corresponding quarter last year also mainly due to the difference in timing of Chinese New Year.

#### 16. Comparison of Results with Preceding Quarter

Group revenue for the current quarter, at RM314.8 million, was lower by RM13.7 million versus the previous quarter. This was primarily due to the timing of Chinese New Year sales.

Profit before tax for the Group was lower by RM2.7 million or 5.8% as compared to the preceding quarter.

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#### 17. Prospects

The global financial crisis and economic slowdown have negatively impacted worldwide and Malaysian demand resulting in slowing growth of industry volume.

In response, the Group will pay very close attention to costs whilst also implementing actions and activities which it expects to stimulate consumer and trade demand. The Group believes this combination will enable us to further strengthen our market leadership.

In spite of the tough economic environment for 2009, the Group expects to deliver satisfactory results for the financial year ending 30 June 2009.

No profit forecast was issued during the financial quarter under review.

#### 24. Off Balance Sheet Financial Instruments

#### Forward Foreign Exchange Contracts

Forward foreign exchange contracts are used by the Group as hedges in currencies other than the functional currency to manage exposure to fluctuations in foreign exchange risk. Under the Group accounting policies, foreign currency transactions that are hedged by forward foreign exchange contracts are booked in at the contracted rates. Foreign currency monetary assets and liabilities which are not hedged are translated at exchange rates ruling at balance sheet date.

As at 7 May 2009, the notional amount of forward foreign exchange contracts that were entered into by the Group to hedge its foreign purchases was RM6.4 million. The settlement dates of these forward contracts ranged between 1 and 6 months.

There is minimal credit and market risk as the above forward contracts are executed with creditworthy financial institutions. The Group is of the view that the possibility of non-performance by these financial institutions is remote on the basis of their financial strength.

#### 25. Material Litigation

Save and except as disclosed in previous quarterly result announcements and where applicable as disclosed in the audited financial statements of the Company or its subsidiaries, neither the Company nor any of its subsidiaries is engaged in any other material litigation either as Plaintiff or as Defendant as of the date of this report.

#### 26. Dividend

The Board of Directors does not recommend any dividend to be paid in respect of the quarter ended 31 March 2009.

Total dividend declared for the current financial period ended 31 March 2009 amounted to 10 sen per 50 sen stock unit tax exempt.
