### 1. Basis of preparation

The interim financial report is unaudited and has been prepared in accordance with Financial Reporting Standards ("FRS") 134 "Interim Financial Reporting" and the applicable disclosure provisions of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad and should be read in conjunction with the Group's audited financial statements for the financial year ended 30 June 2007.

The accounting policies and presentation adopted for this interim financial report are consistent with those adopted in the audited financial statements for the financial year ended 30 June 2007 except for the changes in accounting policies and presentation resulting from the adoption of applicable FRSs adopted by the Malaysian Accounting Standards Board that are effective for the financial period beginning after 1 October 2006 and I July 2007 as follows:-

The adoption of FRS 117 has resulted in a retrospective change in the accounting policy relating to the classification of leasehold land. The up-front payments made for the leasehold land are classified as prepaid lease payments and are amortised on a straight-line basis over the remaining lease term of the land. Where the leasehold land had been previously revalued, the unamortized revalued amount of leasehold land is retained as surrogate carrying amount of the prepaid lease payments as allowed by the transitional provisions of FRS 117.

Prior to 1 July 2007, leasehold lands were classified as property, plant and equipment and were stated at cost / valuation less accumulated depreciation and accumulated impairment.

### 6. Issuances, cancellations, repurchases, resale and repayments of debt and equity securities

- (a) During the quarter under review and financial year-to-date, the Company bought back 1,000 of its own shares from the open market for a total consideration of RM4,220. The total number of shares bought back as at 31 December 2007 was 8,427,500 shares and the shares are being held as treasury shares in accordance with the requirement of Section 67A of the Companies Act, 1965.
- (b) There were no share options granted during the quarter under review and financial year-to-date. As at 31 December 2007, the Group granted 2,000,000 conditional incentive share options ("Options") to eligible executives of the Group pursuant to the Executive Share Option Scheme ("ESOS") of the Company which was established on 23 January 2006, subject to the achievement of certain performance criteria over an option performance period.
- (c) There were no additional shares purchased by the trust set up for the ESOS ("ESOS Trust") during the quarter under review and financial year-to-date. The total number of shares purchased by the ESOS Trust as at 31 December 2007 was 10,000,000 shares ("Trust Shares").

There were no issuance of shares, share cancellation, resale of treasury shares nor repayment of debt or equity securities during the quarter under review and financial year-to-date.

- (c) Allied Auto Parts Sdn Bhd, a 69.4% subsidiary;
- (d) Guolene Paper Products Sdn Bhd, a wholly-owned subsidiary of the Company

The liquidations are currently pending tax clearance from the Inland Revenue Board.

### 12. Contingent liabilities or contingent assets

There are no contingent liabilities or contingent assets as at the date of this report.

### 13. Review of Performance

For the quarter under review, the Group recorded a revenue and profit before taxation ("PBT") of RM781.9 million and RM106.1 million respectively as compared with a revenue and PBT of RM687.3 million and RM75.2 million respectively recorded in the preceding year's corresponding quarter.

The higher PBT as compared with the preceding year's corresponding quarter was mainly attributable to the improvement in profits of the semiconductor and motorcycles businesses due to the higher sales achieved which was partly offset by the lower profit contribution from the associated companies.

For the financial year-to-date, the Group recorded a PBT of RM184.8 million as compared with a PBT of RM173.2 million recorded in the preceding year's corresponding period. The higher PBT as compared with the preceding year's corresponding period was mainly attributable to the improvement in profits of the motorcycles business as a result of higher demand in the domestic market.

### 14. Material changes in profit before taxation against the immediate preceding quarter

The Group's PBT increased to RM106.1 million from a PBT of RM78.8 million recorded in the preceding quarter. The increase is mainly attributable to the improvement in profit of the semiconductor business due to the higher sales achieved.

### 15. Prospects

Barring any unforeseen circumstances, the Board expects the Group's performance to be satisfactory for the current financial year ending 30 June 2008.
