K1 Review of Performance

For the financial quarter under review, the Group registered a lower revenue of RM120.360 million compared to last year's corresponding quarter revenue of RM132.457 million, lower by 9%. The travel and ticketing business registered a lower revenue. However the revenue from the health food, hotel and cards businesses were higher.

The Group recorded a profit before tax of RM4.538 million against last year's corresponding quarter loss before tax of RM4.495 million. Many of our group companies registered improved profits. There was a write back of impairment provision of land and development expenditure of RM8.2 million no longer required.

Group profit for the quarter was RM4.616 million compared to last year's corresponding quarter loss of RM5.119 million.

K2 Variation of Results Against Preceding Quarter

Total revenue for the current financial quarter was RM120.360 million, up 11.0% when compared to preceding quarter's RM112.641 million. Group profit after tax for the quarter was RM4.616 million compared to preceding quarter's profit after tax of RM2.157 million.

K3 Current Year Prospect

The Board is optimistic of the current year prospect albeit the group's businesses are operating in increasingly competitive market.

Not applicable as no profit forecast was published.

K11 Changes in Material Litigation

There is no change in the material litigation from the date of the last quarterly report except for the arbitration proceeding between a subsidiary, Asian Village Antigua Limited ("AVA") and the Government of Antigua and Barbuda ("GAB") pertaining to AVA's land ownership in Antigua and Barbuda. As announced on 2 October 2007, the said arbitration proceeding was concluded with the award by the Tribunal as follows:-

- 1) AVA continues lawfully to hold the AVA land;
- 2) GAB is liable to pay AVA a total of US\$268,137.54 and
- 3) AVA to pay to the GAB the balance purchase consideration of US\$4,000,000 less the said sum of US\$268,137.54 awarded to AVA in 2) above i.e. net sum of US\$3,731,862.46 for the AVA land.
