B1. Review of Performance

(b) Overall Results Commentary:

For the quarter:

The Group recorded revenue of RM163.9 million in the current quarter compared to RM2.6 million in the preceding year quarter. The increase in largely due to the construction revenue recognised in the current quarter pursuant to IC Interpretation 12 (IC12) Service Concession Arrangements pertaining to the highway project.

The Group recorded a pretax profit of RM12.1 million in the current quarter compared to RM41.0 million in the preceding year quarter. The reversal of provision for impairment of RM36.69 million made on the Company's investment in an associate contributed to the higher pretax profit in the preceding year quarter.

B2. Comparison with Preceding Quarter's Results

The Group's revenue increased from RM16.3 million in the preceding quarter to RM163.9 million in the current quarter, attributed to the substantial increase in construction revenue recognized pursuant to IC Interpretation 12 Service Concession Arrangements pertaining to the highway project.

The Group recorded a pretax profit of RM12.1 million in the current quarter compared to a pre-tax loss of RM24.3 million in the preceding quarter due mainly to provision for impairment of investment in an associate and the impairment on property, plant and equipment made in the preceding quarter.

B3. Prospects

(a) The West Coast Expressway (WCE) Project involves the development of a 233 kilometres tolled highway from Banting, Selangor to Taiping, Perak (including 40 kilometres of highway to be constructed later). The WCE Project is a build-operate-transfer project with a concession period of up to a maximum of 60 years. The total project cost is approximately RM5,900 million and revenue from sectional toll collections is expected to commence in 2018. The Construction Commencement Date was set on 25 August 2014 and will take five years to complete. Currently, the construction in on schedule.

On 30 June 2015, West Coast Expressway Sdn Bhd (WCESB) has entered into the following agreements in relation to the establishment of up to RM4.74 billion debt financing facilities for the WCE Project:

- (i) Government Support Loan Facility Agreement with the Government of Malaysia for a term loan facility of up to RM2.24 billion;
- (ii) Facility Agreement with RHB Investment Bank Berhad, RHB Bank Berhad and Malayan Banking Berhad for a syndicated term loan facility of up to RM1.5 billion;
- (iii) Guaranteed Sukuk Murabahah Programme Agreement with Bank Pembangunan Malaysia Berhad and RHB Investment Bank Berhad for an Islamic medium term notes programme of up to RM1.0 billion to be guaranteed by Bank Pembangunan Malaysia Berhad and Danajamin Nasional Berhad pursuant to a Kafalah facility.

The remaining cost of the WCE project will be funded via equity injection from WCESB's shareholders.

(b) Bandar Rimbayu Sdn Bhd, a wholly-owned subsidiary of Radiant Pillar Sdn Bhd, is the developer of a township known as Bandar Rimbayu. As at end June 2015, Bandar Rimbayu has successfully launched five residential phases with the following take-up rates: 98% of Phase 1, 86% of Phase 2, 48% of Phase 3, 69% of Phase 4 and 29% of Phase 5.

Phase 1 comprising 526 units of terrace houses was handed over to purchasers whilst Phase 2 comprising 484 units of terrace house is scheduled to be completed slightly ahead of time and handed over to purchasers from August 2015 onwards.

Phase 6A comprising 48 units of shops is slotted for soft launch in August 2015 and sales are expected to be encouraging.

(c) The Company is also participating in the construction of the WCE as the IJMC-KEB Joint Venture has been appointed as the Turnkey/Engineering and Procurement Contractor for the WCE highway project.

Barring any unforeseen circumstances, the Group expects the results for the current financial year to be satisfactory.

This SSA is subject to the approvals of the shareholders of the Company and the relevant authorities.

Subject to the outcome of such negotiations and approval by the Company's Board of Directors, the Company may thereafter enter into a supplemental agreement with TSCAC to give effect to the modifications (where applicable).
