#### PART B. NOTES PER BURSA MALAYSIA SECURITIES BERHAD LISTING REQUIREMENTS

#### 1. Performance review

Group turnover increased by 9.2% for the first quarter of 2011 as compared with the corresponding quarter of 2010. The Group recorded a profit before tax of RM6,000 in the current quarter as compared with a loss before tax of RM1.78 million in the corresponding first quarter of 2010.

The higher turnover for the current quarter as compared with the corresponding quarter last year was due to higher sales from the tableware division which increased by 186.7%, from RM0.565 million in the first quarter of 2010 to RM1.62 million in the first quarter of 2011 contributed mainly by a specific project sale.

The marginal profit before tax recorded in the current quarter was due to improved sales margin and production efficiencies.

# 2. Comparison with preceding quarter's results

Group turnover increased marginally from RM10.1 million in the fourth quarter of 2010 to RM10.3 million in the current quarter. Current quarter performance resulted in profit before tax of RM6,000 as compared with a loss before tax of RM2.41 million in the preceding quarter. The slight improvement in sales performance was due to a specific project sale from tableware division and the loss in the preceding quarter was mainly attributed to impairment of tunnel kiln of RM2.53 million and provision for slow moving stocks of RM2.15 million.

# 3. Current year prospects

The Group's operating environment, principally within the ceramic building materials industry, remains difficult and challenging, with intense competition from imports sourced from cheaper cost manufacturing countries. However, the Group has taken measures to discontinue manufacture of lower margin products, strengthen its core business in the claypipes division and undertaken cost reduction measures which should result in better performance for the Group in the remainder of the financial year.
