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Schedule E: Selected Explanatory Notes Pursuant to FRS 134

1. Accounting Policies and method of computation

The quarterly financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard (FRS) 134: Interim Financial Reporting and paragraph 9.22 of the Main Market Listing Requirements.

The accounting policies and methods of computation adopted by the Group for the interim financial report are consistent with those adopted in the financial statements for the year ended 30 September 2008 except for the reclassification of revenue, cost of sales and operating expenses to conform with current year's presentation.

The adoption of the above FRSs and Interpretations upon their effective dates is not expected to have any significant impact on the financial statements of the Group, except for changes in disclosures arising from the adoption of FRS 7 and FRS139. The Group is exempted from disclosing the possible impact, if any, to the financial statements upon its initial application of FRS 7 and FRS 139.

2. Auditors' report

The auditors' report of the preceding annual financial statements of the Company and the Group was not subject to any qualification.

3. Comment on seasonality or cyclicality of operation

The Group's performance is normally not affected by seasonal or cyclical events on a year to year basis. However, on a quarter to quarter basis, the demand for certain group products such as soft drinks may be skewed towards the major festivities which normally occur at the end and the beginning of the calendar year.

4. Unusual items due to their nature, size or incidence

There were no unusual items affecting assets, liabilities, equity, net income or cash flow during the quarter except for the following:

- a. a one-time expense of RM4.1 million relating to a voluntary separation scheme (VSS) offered to certain groups of employees in the soft drinks division to streamline production; and
- b. RM39 million increase in goodwill following the acquisition of the remaining 10% equity interest of two subsidiaries within the soft drinks division from The Coca-Cola Company.

5. Significant estimates and changes in estimates

Following the closure of the glass furnace in Petaling Jaya reported in Quarter 2, an additional amount of RM2.2 million was required to write down certain building structures and the remaining obsolete machinery bringing the total closure cost to RM 13.5 million.

There were no other significant changes in estimates that have had any material effect on the results of the current quarter.

6. <u>Issuance or repayments of debt/equity securities</u>

There were no issuance, cancellation, repurchases, resale and repayments of debt and equity securities in the current financial quarter except for the issuance of RM100 million in nominal value of Commercial Paper (CP) of 12 months tenure for working capital purposes.

8. Segmental results

1. Operations review

Current Quarter vs Corresponding Quarter last year

Revenue

Group revenue declined 1% over the corresponding quarter last year on lower sales of the dairies and glass divisions, which was partially offset by higher sales of the soft drinks division.

Soft drinks sales were boosted by a stronger festive demand supported by various marketing and promotional activities. Sales volume and revenue grew 10% and 15% respectively led by strong volume growth in 100PLUS and Seasons products.

Dairies division revenue declined 11%, mainly due to lower sales in Malaysia during the fasting month and higher trade discounting. Domestic sales volume in Thailand was relatively stable but export sales declined.

Glass division was affected by lower sales of the Thai plant and the closure of the Petaling Jaya furnace.

Revenue of the property division reflected progress of construction of Fraser Business Park, Phase II development.

Operating profit

Group operating profit (after unusual items) increased 25% over the previous year mainly due to better margins in the dairies divisions.

Recognition of deferred tax assets amounting to RM12 million resulted in a low effective tax rate of 2% (see note 4 below). Consequently, group profit after tax increased by a disproportionate 80%.

Full year vs Corresponding period last year

For the full year, Group revenue grew a modest 2% to RM3.74 billion against a backdrop of a deep regional economic recession. Soft drinks sales grew by 10% which was partially offset by the drop in the dairies divisions due to the higher trade discounts and lower exports.

Group operating profit (before unusual items) improved by 29% to RM336.8 million due to the strong performance of the soft drinks and dairies divisions. Dairies division had a commendable year in which the operating profit improved by 59% over last year and has overtaken soft drinks as the largest contributor to the Group profits.

Group attributable profit improved 35% due to the lower tax rate of 19% after accounting for deferred tax.

Comment on material change in profit before taxation vs preceding quarter
 Group PBT (after unusual item) for the quarter of RM68 million was 21% lower than the preceding quarter on lower revenue and higher marketing expenses.

3. Prospects for the next financial year

The economies of Malaysia and Thailand are forecasted to return to positive growth next year. This should translate into stronger consumer spending for F&N products. However, prices of raw materials remain volatile although trending upwards and this could erode margins.

Preparations are in full swing to launch new products and strengthen distribution in the soft drinks division as management gears up for the expiry of the Coca Cola transition agreement in September 2011. Dairies division could face margin pressures as raw material prices firmed but sales should improve on better economic conditions and new markets in Indochina.

Glass division should benefit from consolidation of the Malaysian operation following the closure of the PJ factory and better economic conditions.

With the continuing focus and investment in distribution network, brand equity, new products and human capital, the Board is confident that F&N is on a firm footing to face the challenges of the year ahead.

The current quarter deferred tax includes deferred tax assets of RM12 million arising from :

- a. reinvestment allowance tax incentive relating to the new glass furnaces investment in Malaysia (RM9 million) and
- b. deferred tax asset of RM3 million from the China glass subsidiary recognized during the tax exempt period.

The Group's effective tax rate of 19% for the year ended 30 September 2009 was lower than the Malaysian statutory rate of 25% as incomes of certain foreign entities were exempted from tax and tax incentive enjoyed by certain Malaysian entities.

Sale of unquoted investments and properties

There were no sales of unquoted investments or properties in the current financial quarter.

6. Purchase and sale of quoted securities

There were no quoted securities acquired or disposed of in the current financial quarter.

7. Status of corporate proposal

On 3 August 2009, the Company entered into a Share Purchase Agreement to acquire the remaining 10% equity interest in F&NCC Beverages Sdn Bhd and F&N Coca-Cola (Malaysia) Sdn Bhd from The Coca Cola Company for a total consideration of RM78.8 million. The acquisition was completed on 10 September 2009. There were no other outstanding corporate proposals or new announcements made in the current financial quarter.

Any exchange differences arising from these transactions are recognised in income statement in the same period as the underlying hedged transactions.

The above instruments were executed with credit worthy financial institutions in Malaysia and as such, credit and counterparties risks are minimal. There is no cash requirement for these contracts.

10. Pending material litigation

11. Dividends

At the last Annual General Meeting held on 21 January 2009, shareholders approved a final dividend of 30 sen gross per share (22.5 sen net) amounting to RM80.1 million (2008: RM79.1 million) in respect of the financial year ended 30 September 2008 which was paid on 3 March 2009.

An interim dividend of 17 sen gross per share (12.75 sen net) (2008: 17 sen gross per share (12.58 sen net) plus a special tax exempt dividend of 5 sen per share) for the financial year ended 30 September 2009 amounting to RM45.4 million was paid on 6 August 2009.

The Directors are recommending a final dividend of 4 sen gross per share (3 sen net) and 21 sen per share tax exempt together with a bonus tax exempt dividend of 5 sen per share to be approved by shareholders at the forthcoming Annual General Meeting of the Company. If approved, the total dividend for the year would be 41.75 sen net compared to 40.08 sen net (inclusive of a special tax exempt dividend of 5 sen) paid last year.

12. <u>Basis of calculation of earnings per share (EPS)</u>

- (a) The basic EPS for the financial quarter was calculated based on the net profit divided by 356 million ordinary shares (net of treasury shares). There were no changes in the number of issued ordinary shares during the quarter.
- (b) The diluted EPS for the financial quarter was calculated based on the net profit divided by 356 million ordinary shares (net of treasury shares), adjusted for the dilutive effects of potential ordinary shares, namely share options granted pursuant to the Executives' Share Option Scheme ("ESOS").
