#### **EXPLANATORY NOTES PURSUANT TO MFRS 134**

#### A1 Basis of Preparation

The interim financial statements are unaudited and have been prepared in compliance with the requirements of Malaysian Financial Reporting Standard ("MFRS") 134: Interim Financial Reporting issued by the Malaysian Accounting Standards Board ("MASB") and Chapter 9 paragraph 9.22 of the Main Market Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad.

The unaudited interim financial statements should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2016. The explanatory notes attached to the unaudited interim financial statements provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group since the financial year ended 31 December 2016.

#### **A2 Significant Accounting Policies**

#### A2 Significant Accounting Policies (cont'd)

The directors expect that the adoption of the above standards and IC interpretation will have no material impact on the financial statements of the Group upon their initial application, except as discussed below:

#### MFRS 9, Financial Instruments

In November 2014, MASB issued the final version of MFRS 9 Financial Instruments which reflects all phases of the financial instruments project and replaces MFRS 139 Financial Instruments: Recognition and Measurement and all previous versions of MFRS 9. The standard introduces new requirements for classification and measurement, impairment and hedge accounting. MFRS 9 is effective for annual periods beginning on or after 1 January 2018, with early application permitted. Retrospective application is required, but comparative information is not compulsory. The adoption of MFRS 9 will have an effect on the classification and measurement of the Group's financial assets, but no impact on the classification and measurement of the Group's financial liabilities.

#### A3 Seasonal or Cyclical Factors

The business operations of the Group are generally dependent on the state of the overall economic environment.

#### A4 Unusual Items Affecting Interim Financial Report

There were no unusual items as a result of their nature, size or incidence that had affected assets, liabilities, equity, net income or cash flows for the year ended 31 December 2017.

#### **A5 Accounting Estimates**

There were no changes in estimates of amounts reported in prior financial years that have a material effect in the current financial year.

#### A6 Changes in Debt and Equity Securities

There were no issuances, cancellations, repurchases, resale and repayments of debt and equity securities by the Company during the quarter and twelve months ended 31 December 2017 other than the following:

#### (a) Share capital

The new Companies Act 2016 ("CA 2016"), which came into operation on 31 January 2017, abolished the concept of authorised share capital and par value of share capital. Consequently, the amounts standing to the credit of the share premium account becomes part of the Company's share capital pursuant to the transitional provisions set out in Section 618(2) of the CA 2016. Pursuant to subsection 618(3) of the CA 2016, the Group may exercise its right to use the credit amounts being transferred from share premium account within 24 months after the commencement of the CA 2016. The Board of Directors will make a decision thereon by 31 January 2019.

#### (b) Treasury shares

The Company had on 20 June 2017 purchased 10,000 of its own shares from open market at an average market price of RM1.71 per share. The total consideration which amounted to RM0.017 million (inclusive of brokerage fees and stamp duty) were financed by internally generated funds.

#### A7 Dividends Paid

During the financial year ended 31 December 2017, the Company has paid the following dividends:

- (a) a fourth interim single tier dividend of 3.0 sen per share in respect of financial year ended 31 December 2016, amounting to RM42.689 million on 30 March 2017.
- (b) a first interim single tier dividend of 3.0 sen per share in respect of financial year ended 31 December 2017, amounting to RM42.689 million on 29 September 2017.
- (c) a second interim single tier dividend of 4.0 sen per share in respect of financial year ended 31 December 2017, amounting to RM56.918 million on 29 December 2017.

The Group recorded a higher revenue of RM675.1 million in the current year quarter as compared to RM633.8 million in the previous year quarter. The increase in revenue is contributed by the gaming segment. As a result, the Group's pre-tax profit for the current year quarter was higher at RM86.5 million as compared to RM74.5 million achieved in the previous year quarter.

#### Gaming

Gaming sales has increased significantly by RM41.1 million in the current year quarter mainly due to higher sales from its 4D Jackpot game arising from high 4D jackpot prize. In line with the higher revenue but offset by higher prizes payout, the Gaming pre-tax profit has increased by RM14.7 million.

#### **Investment Holdings and Others**

The division reported a pre-tax loss of RM2.4 million in the current year quarter as compared to a pre-tax profit of RM0.4 million in the previous year quarter. This is mainly due to higher fair value loss on quoted investments recorded in the current year quarter.

Group revenue for the current year was lower by RM10.1 million as a result of lower gaming revenue. However, the Group registered a higher pre-tax profit by RM22.3 million mainly contributed by the gaming division.

#### Gaming

Gaming sales for the year ended 31 December 2017 has reduced by RM10.1 million. The drop was mainly attributable to the poor sales recorded in the first quarter where sales in that quarter declined by RM55.5 million mainly due to intense competition from illegal operators and weak consumer spending.

Despite the lower gaming sales, pre-tax profit has increased by RM32.0 million mainly due to lower prizes payout in the current year.

#### **Investment Holdings and Others**

The division recorded a pre-tax loss of RM7.4 million in the current year when compared to a pre-tax profit of RM2.3 million in the previous year. This is mainly due to fair value loss of quoted investments and unrealised foreign exchange loss recorded in the current year as opposed to fair value gain of quoted investments and unrealised foreign exchange gain recognised in the previous year.

When compared to the preceding quarter ended 30 September 2017, the Group reported an increase in revenue of RM18.6 million. This is mainly due to higher gaming sales as a result of higher 4D jackpot prizes in the current quarter. Consistent with the increase in gaming sales of RM18.3 million, pre-tax profit has increased marginally by RM0.1 million mainly due to lower prizes payout in this quarter.

As for the Investment Holdings and Others division, the pre-tax loss was marginally higher than the preceding quarter by RM0.5 million due to higher fair value loss of quoted investments but mitigated by higher dividend income recorded in the current quarter.

#### **B3** Prospects

Magnum Corporation Sdn Bhd is celebrating its 50th year of establishment in 2018 and in conjuction with this milestone, the Company has on 8 January 2018 launched a rebranding & reimaging exercise to help the Company to address stiff competition both from legal as well as illegal operators. With this excercise, all the outlets shall be renovated progressively over the next few years and with a younger and more attractive look, the Company hopes to attract more players especially the younger ones whilst maintaining the present loyal customers to continue to patronise our outlets.

Barring unforeseen circumstances and one off non-recurring event, if any, based on the performance of the last two quarters of 2017, the Board is of the view that the performance of the Company is expected to at least match the 2017 performance especially with regards to revenue.

#### **B9** Material Litigation

On 15 May 2017 and 22 May 2017, the Company and Magnum Holdings Sdn Bhd ("MHSB"), a wholly-owned subsidiary, were served with notices of assessment with penalty for certain prior years of assessment. The additional assessments amounted to RM22.714 million and RM454.382 million respectively, or a combined total of RM477.096 million.

The said notices of assessment were raised principally pursuant to the disallowance of deduction of certain interest expenses incurred for investments. Both Magnum and MHSB had appointed solicitors and had filed for leave application for judicial review and stay of proceedings.

The Kuala Lumpur High Court had on 9 August 2017 granted leave to both Magnum and MHSB to commence judicial review proceedings with the view of quashing the notices of assessments and a stay of proceedings against payment until the disposal of the judicial review.

The hearing dates for the above have been adjourned to 5 April 2018.

#### **B10 Dividends**

The Board of Directors is pleased to declare a third interim single tier dividend of 4 sen per share (2016: 3 sen per share) for the current financial year, bringing the total dividend declared todate for the financial year ended 31 December 2017 to 11 sen per share (2016: 13 sen per share).

The third interim single tier dividend is to be paid on 30 March 2018 to shareholders registered on the Register of Depositors at the close of business on 15 March 2018.

#### **B11 Basic Earnings Per Share**
