B NOTES PER BURSA SECURITIES MAIN MARKET LISTING REQUIREMENTS

B1. Review of Performance

For the financial period ended 31 March 2013, the Group recorded revenue of RM19.6 million compared with revenue of RM18.8 million for the previous period. This was mainly due to higher sales of products in the domestic, which recorded for Crispy and Tango products as a result of more aggressive promotional activities during the current financial period.

Gross profit margin has improved from 33.6% in the previous year to 36.3% for the current period. The higher gross profit margin for the current period was mainly due to lower stock loss.

Despite high revenue, pre-tax profit for the current period remained the same as previous year's corresponding period. This is due to increase of selling and distribution as well as legal expenses.

B2. Material Changes in the Quarterly Results Compared to the Results of the Preceding Quarter

In the current quarter, the Group recorded a revenue of RM19.6 million and a pre-tax profit of RM0.7 million as compared with the preceding quarter's revenue of RM27.2 million and pre-tax profit of RM5.6 million.

The lower revenue for the current quarter was mainly due to higher festive seasons sales in last quarter, which is in line with the seasonal nature of the Group's food and confectionery operations.

B3. Prospects for Year 2013

The global economic situation is expected to remain challenging in 2013. The IMF projects world GDP growth to improve only slightly to 3.3% in 2013 compare with 3.2% in 2012. According to BNM, the local economy in 2013 will be driven by strong domestic demand and supported by gradual improvement of the external environment. BNM has forecast Malaysia GDP to grow between 5.0% and 6.0% in 2013 compare to 2012.

The group will take advantage of strong domestic demand by continuing with its competitive strategy of further developing its range of products to enhance its market position, strengthen the distribution of agency brands and rationalise its manufacturing facilities to improve productivities. The group also continues to explore new markets overseas.
