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1. Basis of preparation

The interim financial report is unaudited and has been prepared in accordance with Financial Reporting Standards ("FRS") 134 "Interim Financial Reporting" and the applicable disclosure provisions of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad and should be read in conjunction with the Group's audited financial statements for the financial year ended 30 June 2007.

The accounting policies and presentation adopted for this interim financial report are consistent with those adopted in the audited financial statements for the financial year ended 30 June 2007 except for the changes in accounting policies and presentation resulting from the adoption of applicable FRSs adopted by the Malaysian Accounting Standards Board that are effective for the financial period beginning after 1 October 2006 and I July 2007 as follows:-

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1. Basis of preparation (Cont'd)

The adoption of FRS 117 has resulted in a retrospective change in the accounting policy relating to the classification of leasehold land. The up-front payments made for the leasehold land are classified as prepaid lease payments and are amortised on a straight-line basis over the remaining lease term of the land.

Prior to 1 July 2007, leasehold land were classified as property, plant and equipment and were stated at cost less accumulated depreciation and accumulated impairment.

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8. Segmental reporting

The Group is solely involved in the business of manufacturing and sale of wood-based furniture. Accordingly, information by industry segment on the Group's operations as required by FRS 114 is not presented.

9. Valuations of property, plant and equipment

This note is not applicable, as no valuation had been carried out for the property, plant and equipment of the Group.

10. Material events not reflected in the financial statements

There are no material subsequent events to be disclosed as at the date of this report.

11. Changes in the composition of the Group

There were no changes in the composition of the Group during the current quarter under review, including business combinations, acquisition or disposal of subsidiaries and long-term investments, restructurings and discontinued operations.

12. Contingent liabilities or contingent assets

There are no contingent liabilities or contingent assets as at the date of this report.

13. Review of Performance

The Group registered a revenue of RM8.4 million for the quarter under review, a decrease of 45% as compared with RM15.3 million registered in the preceding year's corresponding quarter. The Group posted a loss before taxation ("LBT") of RM1.2 million for the quarter under review as compared with a LBT of RM2.3 million recorded in the previous year's corresponding quarter due to improvement in gross profit margin.

The Group's LBT for the current year-to-date closed at RM5.5 million as compared with a LBT of RM3.5 million achieved in the preceding year's corresponding period. The higher loss was mainly attributed to lower sales volume and appreciation of the Ringgit against the US Dollar.

14. Material changes in PBT against the immediate preceding quarter

The Group recorded a LBT of RM1.2 million for the quarter under review as compared with a LBT of RM0.9 million achieved in the preceding quarter due to the factors as explained in note 13.

15. Prospects

With the right sizing measures carried out earlier and the encouraging response from our targeted clients from the hospitality furniture market thus far, the Board expects the performance of the Group to improve for the financial year ending 30 June 2009
