1. Basis of preparation

The interim financial report is unaudited and has been prepared in accordance with Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards 134 "Interim Financial Reporting" and the applicable disclosure provisions of the Main Market Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad and should be read in conjunction with the Group's audited financial statements for the financial year ended 30 June 2017. This interim financial report also complies with International Accounting Standards 34 "Interim Financial Reporting" issued by the International Accounting Standards Board.

The accounting policies and presentation adopted for this interim report are consistent with those adopted in the audited financial statements for the financial year ended 30 June 2017 except for the adoption of MFRS 9 Financial Instruments on 1 July 2017. The adoption of MFRS 9 does not have any material impact on the financial statements of the Group except for the following:

Classification of financial assets and financial liabilities

Equity investments held by the Group were previously classified as fair value through profit or loss and available for sale where the fair value gains or losses were recognised in the profit or loss and other comprehensive income respectively. The fair value gain or loss recognised in other comprehensive income was recycled to profit or loss upon disposal of the financial asset. In accordance with MFRS 9, the Group's equity investments are measured at fair value, and the Group elected to recognise the fair value gain or loss in the other comprehensive income. Such fair value gain or loss is not permitted to be recycled to profit or loss upon disposal of the equity instrument.

The Group has also adopted the MFRSs, amendments and interpretations effective for annual period beginning on or after 1 January 2017 where applicable to the Group. The initial adoption of these applicable MFRSs, amendments and interpretations do not have any material impact on the financial statements of the Group.

2. Qualification of audit report of the preceding annual financial statements

The audit report for the preceding annual financial statements was not qualified.

3. Seasonality or cyclicality of interim operations

There have been no material seasonal or cyclical factors affecting the results of the quarter under review.

4. Nature and amount of items affecting assets, liabilities, equity, net income, or cash flows that are unusual because of their nature, size, or incidence

There were no items affecting assets, liabilities, equity, net income, or cash flows that are unusual because of their nature, size, or incidence during the quarter under review and financial year-to-date.

10. Changes in the composition of the Group (cont'd)

On 14 December 2017, Flynex Sdn Bhd (formerly known as Hume Concrete Marketing Sdn Bhd) ["Flynex"], a wholly-owned subsidiary of Hume Concrete Sdn Bhd which in turn is a subsidiary of the Company, had been placed under member's voluntary liquidation pursuant to Section 439(1)(b) of the Companies Act 2016. Mr Ling Kam Hoong of Messrs Ling Kam Hoong & Co. has been appointed as liquidator of Flynex.

11. Review of performance

For the quarter under review, the Group recorded revenue of RM162.9 million and loss before taxation ("LBT") of RM5.4 million as compared with revenue and profit before taxation ("PBT") of RM165.7 million and RM12.0 million respectively for the corresponding quarter of the preceding financial year ended 30 June 2017 ("FY 2017"). For the financial year-to-date, the Group recorded revenue of RM324.7 million and LBT of RM4.8 million respectively as compared with a revenue and PBT of RM315.6 million and RM23.1 million recorded in the corresponding period of FY 2017.

Despite the higher revenue recorded for the financial year-to-date, the decline in PBT was mainly due to lower selling price and higher operating expenses.

12. Material changes in PBT against the immediate preceding quarter

The Group recorded a LBT of RM5.4 million for the quarter under review as compared with a PBT of RM0.6 million for the preceding quarter. The decrease in the PBT for the quarter under review was mainly attributable to lower selling price.

13. **Prospects**

The business environment is expected to remain challenging in this financial year ending 30 June 2018. Moving forward, the Board believes that the demand for cement and concrete products will improve with the impending implementation of major infrastructure projects in the country.

21. Earnings Per Ordinary Share

(a) Basic earnings per ordinary share

The basic earnings per ordinary share for the quarter under review is calculated by dividing the Group's loss attributable to owners of the Company of RM4,435,000 (2nd quarter 2016/2017: profit attributable to owners of the Company of RM9,196,000) by the weighted average number of ordinary shares during the quarter of 479,093,800 (2nd quarter 2016/2017: 479,093,800).

The basic earnings per ordinary share for the financial year-to-date is calculated by dividing the Group's loss attributable to owners of the Company of RM3,986,000 (2016/2017: profit attributable to owners of the Company of RM17,218,000) by the weighted average number of ordinary shares during the period of 479,093,800 (2016/2017: 479,093,800).

(b) Diluted earnings per share

The Group has no dilution in its earnings per ordinary share in the quarter under review / financial year-to-date and preceding year corresponding quarter / period as there were no dilutive potential ordinary shares.

22. Derivatives

The Group uses forward foreign exchange contracts and interest rate swap contracts to manage its exposure to various financial risks.

(a) Forward foreign exchange contracts

The Group has entered into a number of forward foreign exchange contracts by a subsidiary to hedge the cash flow risk in relation to the variations of cash flows arising from future forecasted transactions.

The forward foreign exchange contracts are stated at fair value using observable market prices in active markets, including recent market transactions and valuation techniques that include discounted cash flow models and option pricing models, as appropriate.

(b) Interest rate swap contracts

The Group has entered into interest rate swap contracts by a subsidiary to convert floating rate liabilities to fixed rate liabilities to mitigate the Group's exposure from adverse fluctuations in interest rates on underlying debt instruments.

The differences between the floating rate and fixed rate calculated by reference to the agreed notional contract principal amounts were exchanged at periodic intervals.
