#### **B1.** Review Of Performance

The Group's total Profit Before Tax(PBT) for FY10-Q1 was RM6.0 mil as compared to RM29.3 mil in FY09-Q1.

This 80% drop in the Group's PBT was mainly due to the Plantation division where its PBT decreased by 93% from RM25.7 mil (FY09-Q1) to RM1.9 mil (FY10-Q1) as a result of the significant decrease in internal FFB production coupled with lower average selling prices of CPO and PK and RM3.2 mil of replanting expenses incurred.

As for the HP division, PBT for FY10-Q1 has improved by RM0.5 mil or 14% to RM4.1 mil as compared to RM3.6 mil as in FY09-Q1.

## B2 Comparison of Results with Preceding Quarter

The Group's total Profit Before Tax(PBT) for current quarter was RM6.0 mil as compared to RM9.8 mil of the immediate preceding quarter.

The 39% drop in the Group's PBT was mainly due to the Plantation division's PBT decreasing by 74% from RM7.2 mil to RM1.9 mil as a result of lower internal FFB production and higher replanting expenses despite better OER and KER, and higher average selling prices of CPO and PK during the current financial quarter.

The HP division's PBT increased by RM1.5 mil or 58% to RM4.1 mil as compared to RM2.6 mil as in the immediate preceding quarter.
