

<u>Part A – Explanatory Notes Pursuant To Malaysian Financial Reporting Standard (MFRS) 134 "Interim Financial Reporting"</u>

A1. Basis Of Preparation

The interim financial report is unaudited and has been prepared in accordance with MFRS 134 "Interim Financial Reporting" and paragraph 9.22 of the Bursa Malaysia Listing Requirements.

The interim financial report has been prepared on a condensed basis and as such it should be read in conjunction with the audited annual financial statements for the financial year ended 31 May 2015.



The initial application of the abovementioned accounting standards, amendments or interpretations are not expected to have any material financial impacts to the current period and prior period financial statements of the Group and the Company except as mentioned below:

MFRS 9, Financial Instruments

MFRS 9 replaces the guidance in MFRS 139, *Financial Instruments: Recognition and Measurement* on the classification and measurement of financial assets and financial liabilities, and on hedge accounting.

The Group is currently assessing the financial impact that may arise from the adoption of MFRS 9.

MFRS 15, Revenue from Contracts with Customer

MFRS 15 replaces the guidance in MFRS 111, Construction Contracts, MFRS 118, Revenue, IC Interpretation 13, Customer Loyalty Programmes, IC Interpretation 15, Agreements for Construction of Real Estate, IC Interpretation 18, Transfers of Assets from Customers and IC Interpretation 131, Revenue – Barter Transactions Involving Advertising Services.

The Group is currently assessing the financial impact of adopting MFRS 15.

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Quarterly Performance Review

Revenue of the Group for the third financial quarter ended 29 February 2016 of RM14.59 million was 1.08% lower than the preceding corresponding financial quarter of RM14.75 million.

Whereas, cost of sales of the Group for the current quarter have reduced by 5.97% to RM12.44 million from RM13.23 million in the preceding corresponding quarter mainly due to the difference in contracted soap chip prices.

Also, during the current quarter, the Group reported a forex gain of RM0.57 million in comparison to RM0.82 million in the preceding corresponding quarter.

Overall, the Group reported a profit before taxation for the current quarter of RM1.13 million as compared to a profit before taxation of RM0.78 million in the preceding corresponding quarter.

Financial Year Performance Review

Manufacturing segment

For the nine months ended 29 February 2016, revenue increased by 10.30% from RM29.91 million to RM32.99 million mainly due to higher sales volume during the current period. Segment profit increased from RM0.85 million to RM4.03 million mainly due to currency exchange gain and difference in contracted soap chip prices.

Trading segment

For the nine months ended 29 February 2016, revenue decreased by 0.78% from RM6.41 million to RM6.36 million. The segment loss of RM0.74 million was mainly due to sharing of operating expenses.

Integrated hotel operation and property investment segment

For the nine months ended 29 February 2016, the performance of the integrated hotel operation and property investment segment remain quite consistent with that of the preceding year corresponding period in 2015. Revenue remained at RM4.60 million for both periods while segment profit increased from RM0.21 million in the preceding corresponding period to RM0.22 million in the current period.

B2. Variation Of Current Quarter Results Compared With The Preceding Quarter

Revenue for the current quarter was RM14.59 million compared to RM14.18 million recorded in the immediate preceding quarter.

The Group's profit before taxation for the current quarter was RM1.13 million compared to the profit before taxation of RM1.47 million for the preceding quarter.

B3. Current Year Prospects

Current economic situation presents challenging business conditions for the Group. However, the Group will keep pursuing its initiatives to further optimize its operations.

The Board of Directors believes that the performance of the Group for the remaining financial year 2015/2016 will remain challenging in the current business conditions.
