#### A1. Basis Of Preparation

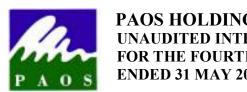

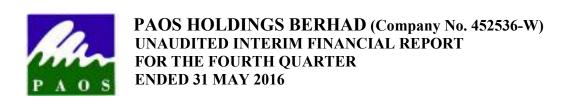

The Group is currently assessing the financial impact that may arise from the adoption of MFRS 9.



## MFRS 15, Revenue from Contracts with Customer

MFRS 15 replaces the guidance in MFRS 111, Construction Contracts, MFRS 118, Revenue, IC Interpretation 13, Customer Loyalty Programmes, IC Interpretation 15, Agreements for Construction of Real Estate, IC Interpretation 18, Transfers of Assets from Customers and IC Interpretation 131, Revenue – Barter Transactions Involving Advertising Services.

The Group is currently assessing the financial impact of adopting MFRS 15.

The audit report in respect of the financial statements of the Group for the preceding year was not subject to any qualification.

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## **Quarterly Performance Review**

Revenue of the Group for the fourth financial quarter ended 31 May 2016 of RM30.15 million was 84.40% higher than the preceding corresponding financial quarter of RM16.35 million mainly due to new trading sales of fuel oil.

Whereas, cost of sales of the Group for the current quarter have increased by 87.34% to RM27.82 million from RM14.85 million in the preceding corresponding quarter mainly due to fuel oil trading.

Overall, the Group reported a profit before taxation for the current quarter of RM2.03 million as compared to a profit before taxation of RM1.94 million in the preceding corresponding quarter.

#### **Financial Year Performance Review**

## **Manufacturing segment**

For the twelve months ended 31 May 2016, revenue increased by 10.93% from RM41.24 million to RM45.75 million mainly due to higher sales volume during the current period. Segment profit increased from RM2.46 million to RM4.78 million mainly due to currency exchange gain and difference in contracted soap chip prices.

#### **Trading segment**

For the twelve months ended 31 May 2016, revenue increased by 129.99% from RM9.95 million to RM22.18 million while segment profit increased from RM0.09 million to RM0.39 million mainly due to new fuel oil sales.

## **Integrated hotel operation and property investment segment**

For the twelve months ended 31 May 2016, the performance of the integrated hotel operation and property investment segment remain quite consistent with that of the preceding year corresponding period in 2015. Revenue and segment profit increased from RM6.09 million and RM0.27 million in the preceding corresponding period to RM6.17 and RM0.31 million in the current period.

#### B2. Variation Of Current Quarter Results Compared With The Preceding Quarter

Revenue for the current quarter was RM30.15 million compared to RM14.59 million recorded in the immediate preceding quarter.

The Group's profit before taxation for the current quarter was RM2.03 million compared to the profit before taxation of RM1.13 million for the preceding quarter.

#### **B3.** Current Year Prospects

The Group's performance for the current financial year ended 31 May 2016 has improved compared to the preceding financial year ended 31 May 2015.

However, the Group anticipates the current economic situation will continue to present challenging business conditions. The Group will keep pursuing its initiatives to further optimize its operations.

The Board of Directors believes that the performance of the Group for the forthcoming financial year 2016/2017 will remain challenging in the current business conditions.

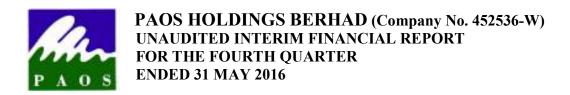
