1. Corporate information

Hup Seng Industries Berhad is a public limited liability company incorporated and domiciled in Malaysia, and is listed on the Main Market of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad.

2. Basis of Preparation

These condensed consolidated interim financial statements, for the period ended 30 June 2015, have been prepared in accordance with MFRS 134 Interim Financial Reporting and paragraph 9.22 of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad.

The Group monitors capital on the basis of the gearing ratio. The ratio is calculated as the total liabilities to total equity. Total equity is the sum of total equity attributable to shareholders. The gearing ratio as at 30 June 2015 and 31 December 2014, which are within the Group's objectives for capital management, are as follows:

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Part B: Explanatory notes pursuant to Main Market Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad For the period ended 30 June 2015

17. Performance review

The Group's revenue for the current quarter ended 30 June 2015 has increased by 4% to RM71,240,000 from RM68,254,000 in the quarter ended 30 June 2014. Benign growth in demand for biscuits in local and export market mainly contributed to increase in sales volume.

The Group register a profit before tax of RM19,575,000 as compared to a profit before tax of RM13,284,000 in the preceding corresponding quarter, an increase of about 47% mainly due to improved sales margin brought about by lower input costs, weak Ringgit and successful modification in pricing strategy.

For the six months ended 30 June 2015, the Group's turnover grew by 7% from RM142,346,000 to RM132,704,000 for the same period last year driven by both domestic and export sales. Cream Crackers continued to be the strong performer in terms of growth for the Group during the period.

The Group register a profit before tax of RM37,378,000 as compared to a profit before tax of RM26,344,000 in the preceding corresponding period. The increase in profit before tax is mainly due to the improved sales margin brought about by lower input costs, weak Ringgit and successful modification in pricing strategy. The increase in sales volume also contributed to the improvement in profit before tax.

18. Comment of material change in profit before taxation

Group's revenue has slightly increased to RM71,240,000 in the current quarter ended 30 June 2015 as compared to RM71,106,000 in the preceding quarter.

Profit before tax, on the other hand, has improved to RM19,575,000 as compared to RM17,803,000 in the preceding quarter brought by improved sales margin due to lower input costs and successful modification in pricing strategy.

19. Commentary of prospects

The external environment is expected to remain tough under the current environment fraught with uncertainties and challenges. However, soft CPO and crude oil prices coupled with favourable demand for Groups' products have contributed strongly to the earnings for the Group in the first half of this year. Recent reports on forecasts for global supply and demand for these commodities suggest a price recovery in second half of 2015 may not be afoot. This bodes well for the Group's performance for the remaining part of the year.

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20. Profit forecast or profit guarantee
