Notes to the condensed consolidated interim financial statements

1. Basis of preparation

The condensed consolidated interim financial statements for the period ended 31 March 2014 have been prepared in compliance with Financial Reporting Standards ("FRS") 134 Interim Financial Reporting and paragraph 9.22 of the Main Market Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad. The Report should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements of the Group for the year ended 31 December 2013.

The accounting policies used in the preparation of condensed consolidated interim financial statements are consistent with those previously adopted in the audited financial statements of the Group for the year ended 31 December 2013. These explanatory notes attached to the interim financial statements provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to the understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group since the financial year ended 31 December 2013.

2. Changes in accounting policies

Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards

On 19 November 2011, the Malaysian Accounting Standards Board (MASB) issued a new MASB approved accounting framework, the Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards (MFRS Framework).

The MFRS Framework is to be applied by all Entities Other Than Private Entities for annual periods beginning on or after 1 January 2012, with the exception of entities that are within the scope of MFRS 141 Agriculture (MFRS 141) and IC Interpretation 15 Agreements for Construction of Real Estate (IC 15), including its parent, significant investor and venture (herein called 'Transitioning Entities').

Transitioning Entities will be allowed to defer adoption of the new MFRS Framework for an additional one year. Consequently, adoption of the MFRS Framework by Transitioning Entities will be mandatory for annual periods beginning on or after 1 January 2015.

The Group falls within the scope definition of Transitioning Entities and have opted to defer adoption of the new MFRS Framework. Accordingly, the Group will be required to prepare financial statements using the MFRS Framework in its first MFRS financial statements for the year ending 31 December 2015. In presenting its first MFRS financial statements, the Group will be required to restate the comparative financial statements to amounts reflecting the application of MFRS Framework. The majority of the adjustments required on transition will be made, retrospectively, against opening retained profits.

The Group expects to be in a position to fully comply with the requirements of the MFRS Framework for the financial year ending 31 December 2015.

3. Auditors' report

The auditor's report on the preceding annual financial statements was not qualified.

4. Seasonal and cyclical factors

The business of the Group is cyclical in nature and the third quarter is normally the peak production season.

5. Unusual items

There were no unusual items affecting assets, liabilities, equity, net income or cash flows during the financial period ended 31 March 2014.

1. Review of performance

Current Quarter vs. Previous Year Corresponding Quarter

The Group recorded a revenue of RM71.83 million and profit before tax of RM9.67 million for the current quarter ended 31 March 2014 as compare to a revenue of RM51.53 million and profit before tax of RM4.06 million in the preceding year quarter ended 31 March 2013. The increase in revenue and profit before tax is mainly due to higher prices of CPO and kernel by 21% and 77% respectively and higher sales volume of CPO and kernel by 6% and 46% respectively.

Performance of the respective operating business segments for this quarter under review as compared to the previous corresponding quarter is analysed as follows:

- (i) Plantation The increase in profit before tax by RM 7.12 million (179%) to RM 11.09 million was due to a 27% increase in FFB price despite a 2% decrease in FFB production.
- (ii) Oil Mill The decrease in profit before tax by RM 0.51 million (47%) to RM 0.58 million was mainly due to lower margin as a result of stiff competition on sourcing the fresh fruit bunches.
- (iii) Power Plant The increase in loss before tax by RM 0.97 million (1,276%) to RM 1.05 million was due to higher operating cost incurred as a result of the commencement of the operation.

2. Variation of results against preceding quarter

The profitability for the current quarter is lower than the immediate preceding quarter mainly due to a gain of RM 4.66 million from fair value adjustment of investment properties was recorded in the immediate preceding quarter.

3. Current year prospects

Barring any unforeseen circumstances, the Board is optimistic on the Group's prospects in view that the palm oil prices has currently stabilised to around RM2,650 per MT.
