Of the loss of RM0.99 million in investment holdings, RM0.8 million is due to interest expenses incurred for the investment in China and the balance is due to operating expenses. China operation generated an after-tax loss of RM4.52 million for the quarter ended 31 December 2011. Malaysia manufacturing operation suffered a loss of RM6.02 million. The loss at the trading division is mainly due to the closure of the stores selling Nike products and also clearance of old stock at a steep discount in its warehouse sales.

A4. Unusual items due to their Nature, Size or Incidence

Other than the factor disclosed in note A6, the closure of all outlets selling Nike products have affected the turnover and profit of the trading division. The contribution from the sale of Nike products is about RM15 million per annum, with a net profit margin of 10%.

There were no other changes in estimates that have a material effect in the current quarter results.

A6. Seasonal or cyclical factors

In view that the Group is in the garments and apparels industry specialising in the manufacturing of spring/summer wear and local retail, the demand for garments and apparels is normally higher in the third and fourth quarters of the financial year.

Other than the factor stated above, the group's operations for the current quarter were not affected by other seasonal or cyclical factors.

A7. Dividend paid

No dividend has been paid during the current financial period ended 31 December 2011.

A14. Subsequent events

Pursuant to Practice Note No. 1 of the Main Market Listing Requirements of the Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad, the Board of Directors of Hytex Integrated Berhad had on 16 August 2011, announced that Hytex Integrated Berhad, Hytex Apparels Sdn Bhd, Hytex Garments (M) Sdn Bhd and WOC Boutique Sdn Bhd have, pending the finalization of an acceptable debt restructuring scheme, deferred the repayments of the principal and interest of their respective banking facilities.

The Group has submitted to its lenders at the end of October 2011 its proposed restructuring scheme and is currently at the stage of negotiations with its lenders to finalize the debt restructuring scheme.

A restraining order was granted by the Kuala Lumpur High Court pursuant to Section 176(10) of the Companies Act, 1965 to Hytex Integrated Berhad and its subsidiaries, namely Hytex Apparels Sdn Bhd, Hytex Garments (M) Sdn Bhd and WOC Boutique Sdn Bhd for a period of one (1) month from 13 February 2012 to 12 March 2012.

A15. Inventories

As at 31 December 2011, the Group has not made any write down or write-off of inventories. However, certain raw materials which are not the best fit for production were utilized, resulting in lower margin. To further generate working capital, some stock of fabrics and finished goods are disposed off for about 30% of its book value only. Warehouse sales were also carried out to clear old stock.

B EXPLANATORY NOTES PURSUANT TO APPENDIX 9B OF THE LISTING REQUIREMENTS OF BURSA MALAYSIA SECURITIES

B1. Review of performance of the Company and its principal subsidiaries - Current Quarter/Year-to-date

For the current quarter ended 31 December 2011, the Group recorded a lower revenue of RM22.1 million as compared to RM32.9 million in the preceding financial year quarter ended 31 December 2010. This represent a decrease of 32.8%. As for the year to date the decrease in revenue is about 13.0% from RM93.6 million in the preceding financial year to RM81.4 million in the current financial year.

The overall performance of the Group for the financial year current quarter ended 31 December 2011 had further declined as indicated by an operating loss of RM13.1 million as compared to an operating loss of RM7.7 million in the preceding financial year quarter ended 31 December 2010. This was due to the lower turnover, decrease in gross profit margin caused by the utilization of raw materials which are not the best fit, appreciation of the Ringgit against the USD and increasing prices of yarn and other cost of production. The year-to-date loss in the current financial period is RM26.1 million as compared to RM13.0 million in the preceding financial year.

Investment Holding: No income were generated from investment holding. The net loss for the current year-to-date is RM4.8 million as compared to RM7.7 million in the preceding financial year. Interest expenses amounted to RM3.9 million for the current year-to-date as compared to RM4.4 million in the preceding financial year.

Manufacturing: Turnover, before deducting inter-co sales, for the current year-to-date amounted to RM63.5 million as compared to RM65.3 million in the preceeding fiancial year. Net loss is RM15.7 million in the current year-to-date as compared to RM8.6 million in the preceeding financial year.

Trading: Turnover for the current year-to-date amounted to RM31.5 million as compared to RM50.6 million in the preceding financial year. Net loss is RM5.6 million in the current year-to-date as compared to a profit of RM3.3 million in the preceding financial year.

B2. Material changes in the quarterly profit before taxation compared to the preceding quarter

Revenue in the current quarter has declined to RM22.1 million as compared to RM26.0 million in the immediate preceding quarter. The loss before taxation for the current quarter ended 31 December 2011 is RM13.1 million as compared to loss before tax of RM6.4 million in the preceding quarter ended 30 September 2011.

The lower revenue is due to the lower OEM orders from Nike. Moreover, as at end of September 2011, all retail outlets selling Nike products had ceased operation with the withdrawal of the trading license by the principal. The contribution to revenue is about RM15 million per annum with a net margin of 10%.

Investment Holding: No income were generated from investment holding. The net loss in the current quarter is RM0.99 million as compared to RM2.03 million. Interest expenses amounted to RM0.8 million for the current quarter as compared to RM1.8 million in the preceeding quarter.

Manufacturing: Turnover, before deducting inter-co sales, for the current quarter amounted to RM17.0 million as compared to RM20.3 million in the preceeding quarter. Net loss is RM10.5 million in the current quarter as compared to RM3.9 million in the preceeding quarter.

Trading: Turnover for the current quarter amounted to RM8.6 million as compared to RM9.3 million in the preceeding quarter. Net loss is RM1.5 million in the current quarter as compared to RM0.4 million in the preceeding quarter. The closure of the stores selling Nike products in September 2011 resulted in a lower turnover and profitability.

B3. Prospects for the remaining periods

The directors do not expect the performance to be better for the remaining periods of the financial year ending 31 March 2012. The strategic direction the Group has now taken is to focus on the local retail business which it hope will contribute positively to the Group. Orders for OEM products are expected to be lower than in the last financial year, with the worsening crisis in Europe and USA.
