20 Review of Group Performance

For the third quarter ended 31 December 2011, the Group achieved a revenue of RM84.251 million which marked an increase of RM34.947 million (71%) as compared to the preceding year corresponding quarter.

The increase in revenue was all from property development segment which registered an increase of RM34.976 million (72%) whereas the rental segment shown a marginal decrease. The strong performance of the current quarter under review were due to better sales and steady construction progress especially projects in Klang Valley namely One South and Symphony Heights.

With commendable growth in revenue, the Group managed to register a profit before tax of RM19.752 million from property development segment. This represents an increase of RM9.487 million (92%) over the preceding year corresponding quarter. After offsetting from rental segment, the Group still recorded a respectable higher profit before tax of RM19.781 million, increased by RM9.425 million (91%) over the preceding year corresponding quarter.

The Group's profit after tax for the quarter under review was RM14.580 million, an increase of RM6.935 million (91%) over the corresponding quarter of RM7.645 million.

The Group's revenue for the period ended 31 December 2011 recorded at RM222.130 million, an increase of RM99.981 million (82%) as compared to revenue of RM122.149 million for the preceding corresponding period.

The property development segment contributed a significant increase of RM100.100 million (83%) in revenue and slight decrease of RM0.119 million (9%) in rental segment due to higher operating cost for our unit which just completed during the financial period.

For the period ended 31 December 2011, the Group chalked up a profit before tax of RM53.928 million, an increase of RM31.175 million (137%) as compared to the preceding year corresponding period. The property development segment contributed RM54.105 million, an increase of RM31.773 million (142%) from the preceding year corresponding quarter while rental segment showed a marginal decrease for the same period.

The Group's profit after tax for the period ended 31 December 2011 was RM40.004 million, an increase of RM23.178 million (138%) from to the preceding year corresponding period of RM16.826 million.

Sales achieved for the period ended 31 December 2011 was 160% higher than the preceding year corresponding period with total unbilled sales of RM505.185 million, giving the group an improved earnings visibility in the remaining period of the FY 2012.

The Group's earnings per share for the period ended 31 December 2011 was 27.74 sen.
