## 1. Basis of Preparation

## 3. Significant Accounting Estimates And Judgements

(a) Critical Judgements Made in Applying Accounting Policies

There are no critical judgements made by management in the process of applying the Group's accounting policies that have significant effect on the amounts recognised in the financial statements.
(b) Key Sources of Estimation Uncertainty

The key assumptions concerning the future and other key sources of estimation uncertainty at the balance sheet date, that have a significant risk of causing a material adjustment to the carrying amounts of assets and liabilities within the next financial year are discussed below.

## (i) Deferred tax assets

Deferred tax assets are recognised for all unused tax losses, unabsorbed capital allowances and unused Reinvestment Allowance to the extent that it is probable that taxable profit will be available against which the losses, capital allowances and reinvestment allowance can be utilised. Significant management judgement is required to determine the amount of deferred tax assets that can be recognised, based upon the likely timing and level of future taxable profits together with future tax planning strategies. The total carrying value of unrecognised tax losses and capital allowances of the Group was RM0.167 million (30.4.2008: RM0.344 million).
(ii) Depreciation of plant and equipment

The cost of paper making machinery is depreciated on a straight-line basis over the assets' useful lives. Management estimates the useful lives of these plant and machinery to be within ten years. These are common life expectancies applied in the industry. Changes in the expected level of usage and technological developments could impact the economic useful lives and the residual values of these assets, therefore future depreciation charges could be revised.

## 4. Auditors' Report on Preceding Annual Financial Statements

The auditors' report on the financial statements for the year ended 30 April 2008 was not subject to any audit qualification.

## 15. Review of performance of the Company and its principal subsidiaries

For the quarter under review, the Group recorded revenue of RM87.28 million and profit before taxation of RM12.84 million as compared to revenue of RM73.07 million and profit before taxation of RM8.47 million for the corresponding quarter in the preceding year.

The increase in revenue of RM14.21 million as compared with the corresponding quarter in the preceding year is contributed by the continued growth in sales of tissue products, sanitary napkins and baby diapers.

The increase in profit before tax of RM4.37 million as compared with the corresponding quarter in the preceding year is mainly due to the increase in revenue in the current quarter.

## 16. Variation of results against preceding quarter

Revenue for the quarter under review has increased from RM73.88 million recorded in the preceding quarter to RM87.28 million in the current quarter mainly due to the increase in sales of tissue products, sanitary napkins and baby diapers.

The Group's profit before taxation has increased from RM10.12 million in the previous financial quarter ended 30 April 2008 to RM12.84 million in the current financial quarter ended 31 July 2008 mainly due to the increase in sales.

## 17. Prospects

The Board of Directors is optimistic that the Group will be able to achieve satisfactory performance in the financial year ending 30 April 2009.
