#### NOTES TO THE UNAUDITED INTERIM FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

#### Part A - Explanatory Notes Pursuant To MFRS 134

#### 1. Basis of preparation

The condensed consolidated interim financial statements ("Report") are unaudited and have been prepared in accordance with MFRS 134: Interim Financial Reporting and paragraph 9.22 of the Main Market Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad.

The interim financial report should be read in conjunction with the most recent annual audited financial statements of the Group for the financial year ended 31 December 2016.

#### 2. Significant accounting policies

#### Comparison with Corresponding Quarter in Previous Year

The Group recorded a revenue and profit before taxation (PBT) of RM40.1 million and RM0.6 million respectively in current quarter under review. The revenue and loss before taxation (LBT) recorded in previous year corresponding quarter were RM29.1 million and RM0.5 million respectively.

The increase was mainly due to the followings:

- a. The increase of revenue in manufacturing segment is mainly due to the increase in sales to a customer in electrical & electronic industry. Manufacturing segment has recorded a revenue and PBT of RM29.8 million and RM0.1 million respectively in current quarter under review;
- b. The gaming & leisure segment recorded a higher revenue in current quarter under review mainly due to the expansion into more provinces in Cambodia. Gaming & leisure segment has recorded a revenue of RM1.1 million and a PBT of RM0.2 million in current quarter under review; and
- c. The Group has recorded a revenue of RM9.2 million in property development & construction segment in current quarter under review. The revenue is mainly generated from the construction project in Kota Baru awarded on 10 March 2017. Property development & construction segment has recorded a PBT of RM0.6 million in current quarter under review.

#### Comparison with Corresponding Financial Period To Date in Previous Year

The Group has recorded a revenue and PBT of RM104.2 million and RM4.9 million respectively in current reporting period. The revenue and PBT was RM85.8 million and RM0.7 million respectively in previous year corresponding period. This was mainly due to the sales recorded in property development & construction segment and the delivery of a higher margin Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) product in manufacturing segment.

The Group has recorded a revenue of RM40.1 million in current quarter under review as compared to a revenue of RM34.5 million in previous quarter. This was mainly due to the sales recorded in property development & construction segment generated from the Kota Baru project abovementioned.

PBT had reduced from RM2.4 million in previous quarter to RM0.6 million in current quarter under review mainly due to the rework incurred and the high production reject in current quarter under review.

The rework incurred mainly on the newly launched products delivered in previous quarters. The Company has not able to anticipate the problems and issues related to long journey delivery. These problems have been overcome with improved packaging.

The high production reject is on the copier equipment and high-fidelity sounds product under the electrical & electronic industry which resulted high material consumed. This was mainly due to the additional processes needed to overcome the faults created by the tools and moulds. The Company has taken steps to rectify the tools and moulds.

The higher PBT in previous quarter also due to the gain on disposal of property, plant & equipment of RM0.5 million.

#### 3. **Prospects**

The Company will continue to rationalise the manufacturing business and will further focus on developing the medical sector as well as continue to explore further business opportunity with existing customers and continue to further enhance the design and Research & Development capabilities

In property development & construction segment, Pengkalan Hulu project is at the finalization of the infrastructure contract before awarding to the respective contractor. As for Kota Baru project, the project is expected to be completed in early 2018. The pre-launch of the marketing activities for Seberang Perai Utara project has started. Besides the three projects abovementioned, the Group had on 2 November 2017 entered into a joint venture agreement to develop a land in Hulu Langat, Negeri Selangor into commercial or residential or mixed commercial and residential estate. The Board believes that the property development & construction segment has a great potential to grow especially with the current demand for affordable housing. The Board believes that this segment will enhance the revenue and profitability of the Group.

Pan Cambodian Lottery Corporation Limited (PCL), a 60% owned subsidiary of LIB has expanding into other provinces in Cambodia to further enlarge their sales network. The Group is also looking at strategy to increase the number of the digit game products. As for the plan to establish a gaming entertainment center, PCL is looking at the option of leasing the land and building and is currently in the process of discussion with several gaming operators.

In light of the above and barring any unforeseen circumstances, the Board is cautiously optimistic in delivering a better result in the financial year 2017.

#### Luster Industries Bhd Vs Citi-Champ International Limited & 4 Others

The Company had on 13 June 2017, filed a Statement of Claim at the High Court of Malaya at Shah Alam, through the Company's solicitors, Messrs YC Wong to pursue legal actions against:-

Citi-Champ International Limited (as 1st Defendant);

How Soong Khong (as 2nd Defendant);

Yap Yoke Chuan (as 3rd Defendant);

Yap Kean Kok (as 4th Defendant)

Yew Ding Wei (Practising as Ding Partnership)(as 5th Defendant)

[collectively the "Defendants"]

On 31 October 2017, the Company's application for mareva injunction against the 2nd to 5th Defendants was dismissed with costs whereupon the Company made an oral application for erinford injunction but it was also dismissed. The High Court has fixed trial dates for the suit on 30 May to 1 June 2018, and 4 June 2018. The next case management is fixed on 29 November 2017.

The Company has filed an appeal against the dismissal of its application for mareva injunction on 31 October 2017 and a motion for erinford injunction on 3 November 2017 to the Court of Appeal. The case management for the appeal is fixed on 6 December 2017 while the hearing of the motion is fixed on 18 December 2017.
