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NOTES TO THE FINANCIAL REPORT

A1. BASIS OF PREPARATION

The interim financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost basis, except for investment securities and derivative financial instruments which are stated at fair value.

The interim financial statements are unaudited and have been prepared in accordance with the MFRS 134: Interim Financial Reporting and paragraph 9.22 of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad. This interim financial report also comply with IAS 34 Interim Financial Reporting issued by the International Accounting Standards Board. This interim financial report should be read in conjuction with the audited financial statements of the Group for the year ended 31 December 2012.

The significant accounting policies and methods of computation applied in this report are consistent with those adopted in the financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2012 with the exception for FRS 139, whereby unrealised gains on quoted investments are not recognised in the financial statements until year end. Unrealised losses on quoted investments are recognised immediately whilst unrealised gains will only be recognised at the year end.

A2. AUDIT REPORT OF PRECEDING ANNUAL FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

The financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2012 were not qualified.

A3. SEASONAL OR CYCLICAL FACTORS

The business operations of the Group were not significantly affected by any seasonal or cyclical factors.

A4. NATURE AND AMOUNT OF UNUSUAL ITEMS

There were no items affecting assets, liabilities, equity, net income or cash flows that are unusual because of their nature, size or incidence for the current quarter.

A5. CHANGES IN ESTIMATES

There were no changes to the estimates of amounts reported in prior financial years that may have a material effect in the current quarter.

A6. ISSUANCE OR REPAYMENT OF DEBT AND EQUITY SECURITIES

There were no issuance and repayment of debt and equity securities, share buy-backs, share cancellation or shares held as treasury shares and resale of treasury shares for the current quarter.

A7. DIVIDENDS PAID

The final single tier dividend of 3 sen per share, amounting to RM30 million for the financial year ended 31 December 2012 was paid on 19 June 2013.

A11. CHANGES IN THE COMPOSITION OF THE GROUP

A wholly owned subsidiary, New Johnson Holdings Limited, has incorporated two wholly-owned subsidiaries, Madu Shipping Pte Ltd and Molek Shipping Pte Ltd on 25 April 2013.

A12. CONTINGENT LIABILITIES

There were no contingent liabilities since the last annual balance sheet date to the date of this report.

B1. REVIEW OF PERFORMANCE

The Group posted a profit before tax (PBT) of RM22.7 million in the first half of 2013, a decline of 29% compared to RM32.1 million reported for the same period last year.

The table below summarizes the average time charter equivalent (TCE) for MBC's dry bulk and tanker fleet.

The performance of the respective segments in the first half of 2013 as compared to the same period last year is analysed as follows:-

1) Dry bulk segment

The Group's first half 2013 dry bulk segment turned in a loss of RM15.1 million, against a profit of RM15.0 million recorded in the corresponding period a year ago. The decline was mainly attributed to lower charter rates earned.

2) Tanker segment

The Group's tanker segment reported a profit of RM2.5 million in 1H2013, compared to a RM2.6 million loss in the same period last year. The turnaround was mostly due to improved charter rates earned and increased hire days (15 days).

3) Ship brokerage and management

Profit from this segment increased marginally by RM0.2 million due to higher management fees earned.

4) Investment holding and others

Income from investment holding includes:-

- i) Gain on disposal of asset of RM3.9 million; and
- ii) Share of results of an associate our share of PACC Offshore Services Holdings Pte Ltd results increased 167% to RM31.6 million in 1H2013, from RM11.8 million in the same period last year, due to the improved offshore services sector.

Overall, profit attributable to shareholders declined 31% to RM22.1 million in the first half of 2013, from RM31.8 million registered in the same period last year.

The Group posted a quarterly operating loss of RM0.2 million in April-June 2013, compared to an operating loss of RM6.9 million in the preceding quarter. The improvement was mainly due to higher charter rates earned.

Current quarter's other operating income/(loss) is comparatively lower as the preceding quarter's figure includes a one-off gain on disposal of asset of RM3.9 million. Administrative expenses and finance costs decreased compared to the preceding quarter.

Our associate (POSH) continued to deliver another good quarterly earnings.

All told, profit attributable to shareholders increased by 45% to RM13.1 million in the second quarter of 2013, from RM9.0 million reported in the first quarter of 2013.

B3. PROSPECTS

The International Monetary Fund in its July 2013 World Economic Outlook Update cut its forecast for global growth to 3% for 2013 (from 3 1/4% projected in April 2013) due to slowing emerging markets and the prolonged recession in the euro area.

Growth in the dry bulk fleet continues and is projected at 7% in 2013 whereas trade growth is forecast to reach 5%. The Handymax and Panamax fleets are expected to register the fastest growth in terms of deadweight tonnage in full year 2013 (Clarkson Research).

The Group took delivery of a new Supramax under long term charter in June 2013 and has another 6 new vessels in the pipeline for deliveries in 2014/2015.

The supply side of both dry bulk and tanker continues to put pressure on rates. These two sectors remain challenging.

Our associate, PACC Offshore Services Holdings Pte Ltd (POSH), posted 167% surge in its profit in the first half of the year. The outlook for offshore sector continues to be positive, due to healthy oil prices and projected increases in offshore exploration and production spending. Our associate should continue to contribute positively to the Group's overall performance in 2013.
