# <u>Part B - Explanatory Notes Pursuant to Appendix 9B of the Main Market Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad</u>

# B1. Review of performance Quarter ended 31 March 2015 compared with quarter ended 31 March 2014

Trading conditions in the Group's markets continued to be challenging during the fourth quarter ended 31 March 2015 ('4Q15') as consumer sentiment remained cautious overall and competitors continued aggressive discounting and promotions amidst the ongoing fiscal consolidation in the region.

In Malaysia, the weaker consumer sentiment continued until March when there was some elevated pre-Goods and Services Tax ('GST') spending by consumers overall before the commencement of the GST on 1 April 2015, while in Hong Kong, the anti-parallel trade protests also negatively impacted the Hong Kong retail market.

Against this backdrop, the Group recorded revenue of RM41.2 million and profit before tax ('PBT') of RM7.1 million, as compared to RM33.7 million and RM4.3 million respectively for the prior year corresponding quarter ended 31 March 2014 ('4Q14').

Under the Professional Services and Sales (Corporate Outlets) segment, the Group owned and operated 75 professional skin care salons and retail kiosks across Malaysia, Singapore, Hong Kong and Thailand as at 31 March 2015. Revenue for the quarter of RM24.5 million was 21.5% higher than 4Q14 while operating profit was 33.6% higher at RM3.9 million, supported by more aggressive promotional campaigns during the quarter ahead of the commencement of GST in Malaysia.

Similarly, for the Product Distribution segment (Professional Distribution and Fast Moving Consumer Goods (FMCG)), revenue for the quarter of RM16.6 million was 23.4% higher than 4Q14 while operating profit was 43.8% higher at RM2.2 million due to the Group's promotional campaigns as well as increased contribution from the Group's international brands and launch of certain new products during the quarter.

On a geographic basis, the proportion of revenue from the regional and export business against the domestic business of the Group was 35% and 65% respectively.

### Financial year ended 31 March 2015 compared with previous year ended 31 March 2014

Against the more challenging trading conditions noted above, the Group achieved revenue of RM150.8 million for the financial year ended 31 March 2015 ('FY2015'), an increase of 5.5% over the previous financial year ('FY2014'), while profit before tax ('PBT') was 2.9% higher to RM21.0 million. The lower PBT margin for FY2015 reflects the more aggressive promotions required in the softer trading environment as well as higher inventory costs for the Group due to the strengthening of the US Dollar in FY2015, and one-off accruals associated with the implementation of GST for deferred revenue.

Professional Services and Sales recorded revenue growth of 5.8% to RM87.3 million in the current year, while operating profit increased by 8.1% to RM9.6 million, supported by more aggressive promotions and new product and service offerings launched during the year. The Group strategically invested in expanding and upgrading its network of Corporate Outlets and opened seven new outlets and relocated and renovated another twelve outlets in FY2015. As at 31 March

2015, the Group owned and operated 75 professional skin care salons and retail kiosks across Malaysia, Singapore, Hong Kong and Thailand.

Product Distribution recorded revenue of RM63.2 million for FY2015, which was 4.9% higher than FY2014. However, the segment's operating profit of RM8.3 million was lower than the operating profit of RM11.3 million for FY2014 due to higher non-recurring net foreign exchange gains of RM1.0 million recorded in FY2014, as well as increased brand building and promotional activities and the impact of the stronger US Dollar in the current year.

The revenue contributed from the regional and export business against the domestic business of the Group was 39% and 61% respectively.

# B2. Material changes in the quarterly results compared to the results of the immediate preceding quarter

The Group recorded profit before tax of RM7.1 million from revenue of RM41.2 million in the current quarter ('4Q15'), as compared to profit before tax of RM2.5 million from revenue of RM36.6 million in the preceding quarter ended 31 December 2014 ('3Q15'). The higher profit before tax is due to higher revenue generated from more aggressive promotional activities as well as new product and service offerings in the current quarter, as well as one-off accruals for the implementation of GST for deferred revenue in Malaysia which were recorded in the preceding quarter.

#### **B3.** Commentary on prospects

The beauty and wellness industry in the Group's markets is expected to continue to experience moderate growth over the longer term in spite of more challenging local and regional macro-economic environments.

Barring any adverse developments in local and regional market conditions, the Board continues to adopt focused and prudent strategies to execute the Group's strategic long-term priorities and continue to grow the core brands and businesses of the Group.
