Part B - Explanatory Notes Pursuant to Appendix 9B of the Main Market Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad

B1. Review of performance

Quarter ended 30 September 2018 ('2Q19') compared with quarter ended 30 September 2017 ('2Q18')

The Group recorded revenue of RM44.5 million for 2Q19, which was higher than 2Q18 by 10.5%. The Group's profit before tax was higher by RM2.3 million to RM3.5 million, which was due to higher revenue generated for 2Q19 as well as net foreign exchange gains of RM0.1 million recognised in 2Q19 as compared to a net foreign exchange loss of RM0.9 million in 2Q18. Excluding the net foreign exchange impact, the Group would have recognised a profit before tax of RM3.4 million for 2Q19 as compared to RM2.1 million for 2Q18.

Professional Services and Sales (Corporate Outlets) revenue of RM24.8 million was 7.4% higher than 2Q18, while operating profit was higher by RM1.3 million to RM2.3 million. The Group's network of Corporate Outlets comprised of 74 AsterSpring professional skin care salons, retail kiosks and department store concession counters across Malaysia, Singapore, Hong Kong, Thailand and Indonesia as at 30 September 2018.

Product Distribution (Professional Distribution and Fast Moving Consumer Goods (FMCG)) revenue of RM19.4 million was 14.6% higher than 2Q18. Operating profit improved by RM1.7 million in line with the higher revenue generated in 2Q19 quarter as compared to Q218.

On a geographic basis, the proportion of revenue from the regional and export business against the domestic business of the Group was 38% and 62% respectively.

Half year ended 30 September 2018 ('1H19') compared with half year ended 30 September 2017 ('1H18')

Group revenue increased by RM5.3 million or 6.6% to RM86.3 million for 1H19, while profit before tax of RM7.1 million was higher by RM4.8 million, which was due to higher revenue generated in 1H19 as well as net foreign exchange gains of RM0.9 million in 1H19 as compared to net foreign exchange losses of RM2.3 million in 1H18.

Professional Services and Sales (Corporate Outlets) revenue was 2.7% higher to RM48.4 million for 1H19, while profit before tax of RM4.8 million was RM2.4 million higher than 1H18. The Group's network of Corporate Outlets comprised of 74 AsterSpring professional skin care salons, retail klosks and department store concession counters across Malaysia, Singapore, Hong Kong, Thailand and Indonesia as at 30 September 2018.

Product Distribution (Professional Distribution and FMCG) revenue for IH19 was 12.0% higher at RM37.2 million. Operating profit improved by RM1.8 million to RM1.0 million due to higher revenue as well as net foreign exchange gains of RM0.2 million as compared to net foreign exchange losses of RM1.0 million for IH18.

The revenue contributed from the regional and export business against domestic business of the Group was 37% and 63% respectively.

B2. Material changes in the quarterly results compared to the results of the immediate preceding quarter ended 30 June 2018 ('1Q19')

The Group recorded revenue of RM44.5 million and profit before tax of RM3.5 million for 2Q19, as compared to revenue of RM41.8 million and profit before tax of RM3.7 million for 1Q19. The profit before tax was lower despite higher revenue generated in 2Q19 mainly due to higher net foreign exchange gains in 1Q19 of RM0.8 million as compared to net foreign exchange gains of RM0.1 million in 2Q19.

B3. Commentary on prospects

The beauty and wellness industry in the Group's markets is expected to achieve moderate growth over the longer term, in-line with favourable demographic trends and economic potential in the region. However, should economic conditions remain challenging, consumer spending, including spending for the beauty and wellness industry in the Group's markets, may continue to be impacted over the short term.

Barring any adverse developments in local and regional market conditions, the Board continues to adopt focused and prudent strategies to execute the Group's strategic long-term priorities to grow the core brands and businesses of the Group.
