A1 Corporate Information

LCTH Corporation Berhad is a public limited liability company incorporated and domiciled in Malaysia, and is listed on Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad.

A2 Basis of Preparation

This condensed consolidated interim financial statements ("Condensed Report") have been prepared in accordance with MFRS 134: Interim Financial Reporting and paragraph 9.22 of the Main Market Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad.

The interim financial statements should be read in conjunction with the Group's annual audited financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2012. The explanatory notes attached to these condensed consolidated interim financial statements provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group since the year ended 31 December 2012.

A17 Property, plant and equipment

Acquisition and disposals

During the six months ended 30 June 2013, the Group acquired assets at a cost of RM 1.38 million(30 June 2012: RM1.77million).

Assets with a carrying amount of RM11.46million including assets held for sale were disposed of by the Group during the quarter ended 30 June 2013 (quarter ended 30 June 2012: RM Nil), resulting in a gain on disposal of RM17.31 million (quarter ended 30

June 2012: RM 0.04 million), recognized and included in other income in the statement of comprehensive income.

Impairment loss on property, plant and equipment

During the quarter ended 30 June 2013, the Group provided for impairment loss on the property, plant and equipment of RM1.62 million (quarter ended 30 June 2012: RM7.5million). The impairment loss was made after a review of the recoverable amount of certain plant and equipment. The impairment loss is included in other expenses in the statement of comprehensive income.

B COMPLIANCE WITH APPENDIX 9B OF THE LISTING REQUIREMENTS OF BURSA MALAYSIA

B1 Performance Review

The Group recorded revenue of RM56.9 million for the current quarter, decreased by 41% compared to RM97 million posted in the corresponding quarter of 2012. This is mainly due to the change of procurement strategy of a major customer which resulted in reduction in orders. However, the Group reported a gross profit of RM1.64million for the current quarter as compared to a gross loss of RM0.77 million in the corresponding quarter of 2012. This is attributed to decrease in low margin projects, decrease in depreciation and some effective cost-cutting measures implemented by the Group in response to the drop in revenue.

The Group's revenue of RM105 million for the 6 months period ended 30 June 2013 is 42% lower compared to the RM181 million for the same period in 2012, mainly due to the change in procurement strategy of a major customer as mentioned above.

Profit before tax for the six months ended 30th June 2013 amounted to RM12.72 million and RM 12.13 million after taxation, compared to before tax loss of RM16.19 million and RM15.74 million after taxation in the corresponding period ended 30 June 2012.

The improvement in gross profit, and gain on disposal of assets held for sale contributed to the better operating performance of 2nd quarter of 2013.

B2 Material Changes in Loss before Taxation for the Current Quarter as compared with the immediate Preceding Quarter

The Group's revenue increased by RM8.7million or 18% as compared to RM48 million reported in the 1st quarter of 2013. The Group reported a profit of RM14.19 million before tax compared to loss before tax of RM1.47 million reported in the 1st quarter of 2013.

B3 Prospects

As announced by the Company on 20 June 2013, Classic Advantage Sdn Bhd ("CASB"), a major subsidiary of the Company completed the Agreement for the Sale and Purchase of some of the assets of CASB ("Proposed Disposal"), and executed a sub-tenancy agreement to sub-let a majority part of the factory to the purchaser Flextronics Technology (Penang) Sdn Bhd. ("FTSB").

These exercises are expected to reduce the operating costs of the Group and better position the Group to turn-around.

In view of the keen competition and the uncertain global economic outlook, the Group will strive to secure more new projects from existing and new customers to cushion the reduction in sales order. The Group will focus on right-sizing the operations of CASB and continue to be more focus on its core businesses and costs management to improve the financial results.

The Group did not issue any profit forecast or profit guarantee for the period.

The effective tax rate of the Group for the current quarter and financial year to-date was lower than the statutory income tax rate is mainly due to utilization of unabsorbed tax losses not previously recognized as deferred tax assets in the major subsidiary.

B6 Corporate Proposals

As announced on 24th April 2013, the wholly owned subsidiary CASB intends to utilize proceeds from disposal of assets held for sale as follows:

- (i) RM15.0 million to secure a building, whether to build, rent or purchase, that suits its current business need within twelve months from the effective date of the Sub-Tenancy Agreement. CASB will continue to operate from the Property until then. Any unutilized portion of this allocated amount will be used for CASB's working capital; and
- (ii) RM14.5 million to repay advances from LCTH within 3 months from the completion of the APA.
