Particleboard Manufacturing Sector

The revenue reported for this period decreased by RM30.50 million or 37.26% and a decrease in profit before tax to loss before tax by RM3.92 million or 125.02% respectively, compared to the same period last year. The decrease in revenue and shift from profit before tax to loss before tax was mainly attributable to the lower average selling price, lower sales, and production volumes due to the persistently weak market sentiment during the reporting quarter despite a higher USD/MYR exchange rate. In addition, electricity costs had increased significantly and had impacted the cost of production.

RTA Manufacturing Sector

The revenue reported for this period decreased by RM63.96 million or 42.53% and a decrease in profit before tax to loss before tax by RM12.47 million or 166.35%, respectively compared to the same period last year. The decline in revenue and shift from profit to loss before tax was mainly due to the persistently weak market sentiment during this reporting period.

Fungi Cultivation

The revenue reported for this period decreased by RM29,000 or 1.70%, and the loss before tax decreased by 1.28%. The decrease in revenue was due to increased competition of mushrooms being imported from China. HeveaGro started Grey Oyster Mushrooms cultivation towards end of this reporting period. With 2 types of mushrooms, HeveaGro will be able to increase its capacity utilization to achieve better economies of scale. The management will continue to capture market share by expanding its local distribution channels for both eryngii and grey oyster mushrooms.

B1. Review of performance

The revenue and profit before tax of the Group for the current quarter ended 30 June 2023 were RM61.72 million and RM259,000 respectively. The revenue and profit before tax decreased by RM42.63 million or 40.85% and by RM3.20 million or 92.51% respectively as compared to the corresponding quarter in FY 2022.

The reasons for the decrease in the Group revenue and profit before tax for the reporting period were highlighted in Segmental Reporting A8.

B2. Material change in profit before taxation for the quarter against the immediate preceding quarter

The Group reported a profit before tax of RM259,000 for the current quarter as compared to a loss before tax of RM6.71 million for the immediate preceding quarter that ended 31 March 2023, a change from loss to profit before tax by RM6.97 million or 103.87% due mainly to the particleboard sector achieving higher sales and production volumes in this reporting quarter compared to the immediate preceding quarter.

B3. Prospect for the current financial year

Amidst the increasingly challenging business landscape, both locally and globally, the management will continue to be innovative in facing the challenges ahead by ensuring high product quality, better cost management, improving operational efficiencies, scaling up automation initiatives, and continuing to differentiate ourselves from our competitors. The Board is cautiously optimistic that the Group can overcome the current challenges with better strategies in place.
