## PART A: EXPLANATORY NOTES PURSUANT TO FRS 134

#### 1. BASIS OF PREPARATION

The interim financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention. The interim financial statements are unaudited and have been prepared in accordance with the requirements of Financial Reporting Standards ("FRS") 134: Interim Financial Reporting and paragraph 9.22 of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad.

The interim financial statements should be read in conjunction with the explanatory notes attached to the interim financial statements which provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group.

# 5. UNUSUAL ITEMS DUE TO THEIR NATURE, SIZE OR INCIDENCE

#### 6. SIGNIFICANT ESTIMATES AND CHANGES IN ESTIMATES

There were no changes in estimates that have had a material effect in the current financial year's results.

## 7. SEASONAL AND CYCLICAL FACTORS

The Group's performance would be subject to the risk of increase in downtime and off-hires due to the adverse weather conditions such as monsoon seasons. In this respect, only one (1) of the Group's smaller-sized vessels that is under spot charter contract, and underwater services would inevitably be affected by the monsoon seasons and this would result in fluctuation in the Group's earnings over the financial year.

Notwithstanding the above, twenty four (24) out of the Group's fleet of twenty five (25) vessels are currently under fixed charter contracts whereby the vessels are to be made available regardless of the weather condition. This, in turn, will provide the Group with a steady stream of income.

## 8. DIVIDENDS PAID

No dividend was paid in the current financial quarter under review.

# 9. VALUATION OF PROPERTY, PLANT AND EQUIPMENT

There was no valuation of the property, vessel and equipment in the current financial period under review.

## 10. DEBT AND EQUITY SECURITIES

There were no issuance, cancellations, repurchases, resale and repayments of debts and equity securities except for the following:

Employee Share Options Scheme ("ESOS")

During the financial quarter under review, the Company issued 46,875 ordinary shares of RMo.25 each for cash at an average exercise price of RMo.83 per share pursuant to the AMRB Employee Share Options Scheme (ESOS).

#### 11. CHANGES IN COMPOSITION OF THE GROUP

There were no changes in composition of the Group for the financial quarter under review except for the following:

Acquisition of Alam Food Industries (M) Sdn Bhd ("AFIM")

On 20 June 2008, Alam Maritim (M) Sdn Bhd, a wholly-owned subsidiary of the Company, acquired a new subsidiary namely Alam Food Industries (M) Sdn Bhd with the transfer of two (2) subscribers' shares of RM1.00 each at a consideration of RM2.00. AMSB had subsequently entered into a Shareholders Agreement with Captain Mahamood bin Ibrahim and pursuant to the Shareholders Agreement dated 20 June 2008, AMSB had subscribed a total of 69,998 ordinary shares of RM1.00 each amounting to RM69,998.00 whereas Captain Mahamood Bin Ibrahim had subscribed a total of 30,000 ordinary shares of RM1.00 each amounting to RM30,000.00 shares in AFIM.

As a result of the subscription, both AMSB and Captain Mahamood bin Ibrahim hold 70% and 30% of equity in AFIM, respectively. The principal activities of AFIM are providing and supplying Halal food and beverages and other related services such as lodging-house keepers for the Group's fleet and external parties.

#### 12. CAPITAL COMMITMENTS

#### 13. CONTINGENT LIABILITIES AND CONTINGENT ASSETS

As at 30 June 2008, our contingent liabilities, comprising bank and performance guarantees for contracts entered into with customers, stood at approximately RM9.0 million. In addition, the Company has provided corporate guarantee for the credit facilities totaling USD28.56 million granted by Maybank International (L) Ltd. to 60%-owned subsidiaries of Alam Maritim (M) Sdn. Bhd. ("AMSB"), namely Alam Synergy II (L) Inc., Alam Synergy III (L) Inc., Alam Synergy III (L) Inc.

AMSB has also provided a corporate guarantee for the banking facilities amounting to RM 5.0 million granted by Malayan Banking Berhad to Alam Hidro (M) Sdn. Bhd. ("AHSB"), a 70%-owned subsidiary of AMSB.

Save as disclosed above, there were no material contingent liabilities that may, upon materialisation, have a material effect on the Group's financial results or position.

#### 14. SUBSEQUENT EVENTS

There were no material events subsequent to the end of the current financial year except for the following:

Issuance of Shares

Subsequent to 30 June 2008, the Company issued 6,658,049 ordinary shares of RMo.25 each for cash at an exercise price of RMo.67 per share pursuant to ESOS.

# PART B: EXPLANATORY NOTES PURSUANT TO APPENDIX 9B OF THE LISTING REQUIREMENTS OF BURSA MALAYSIA SECURITIES BERHAD

## 15. PERFORMANCE REVIEW

The Group recorded a turnover of RM138.96 million for the financial period ended 30 June 2008 as compared to RM110.41 million for the corresponding period in the preceding year, resulting in a favourable variance of 25.8%. This is mainly attributable to generally higher revenue derived from both offshore support vessels and underwater services segments spurred by the increase in the number of owned vessels operated by the Group and new contracts secured by underwater services unit.

The profit before taxation for the current financial period of RM43.19 million was 38.0% higher in comparison to RM31.29 million registered for the corresponding period last year, mainly due to higher operating profit contribution from offshore support vessels segment which is in tandem with the higher daily charter rates and expanded fleet of vessels owned and operated by the Group.

#### 16. VARIATION OF RESULTS AGAINST PRECEDING QUARTER

The Group's revenue for the current quarter of RM83.83 million was higher than the preceding quarter's revenue figure of RM55.12 million by 52.1%, mainly due to substantially higher revenue derived from chartering activities of owned and third party vessels during the second financial quarter under review. The revenue derived from underwater services segment was also significantly higher as compared to the preceding quarter supported by several new contracts secured by the Group recently.

The profit before taxation ("PBT") of the Group for the current financial quarter of RM28.05 million was higher than the preceding quarter's PBT of RM15.42 million by 81.9%, which is mainly due to higher overall operating profit contribution from both offshore support vessels and underwater services segments. Besides, the improvement in profit margins derived from chartering activities of owned and third party vessels, arising from higher daily charter rates for new charter contracts secured in the current financial year, has enhanced to certain extent the financial performance of the Group.

#### 17. COMMENTARY ON PROSPECTS

The Group anticipates that the oil majors such as Petronas are still committed to continue with their exploration and production ('E&P') programmes in view of maintaining and/or increasing the current production level. The demand for offshore support vessels is expected to remain bullish with sustainable daily charter rates for the year ahead.

The new vessels scheduled to be delivered this year right up to 2010 are poised to contribute positively to the financial results of the Group with less reliance on third party vessels. In addition, the underwater services segment is currently enjoying healthy growth with several contracts secured recently to further boost up the Group's financial performance for the current financial year.

The Group is also actively seeking new business ventures in related fields as catalysts for growth in view of expanding revenue stream and increasing shareholders' wealth.

## 18. PROFIT FORECAST

The Group has not issued any profit forecast for the current financial year and therefore no comparison is available.

The Securities Commission had, via its letter dated 21 July 2008, approved for an extension of time of another six (6) months up to 26 January 2009 for the Company to complete the private placement exercise.

The remaining placement shares, totaling 15,524,800 ordinary shares of RMo.25 each, have yet to be issued by the Company as of 11 August 2008.
