The Group recorded a turnover of RM79.15 million for the financial period ended 31 March 2014 as compared to RM93.22 million for the same period last year, resulting in an adverse variance of 17.2%. Revenue from Offshore Support Vessels ("OSV") segment was dropped by 31% due to lower average vessel utilisation rate.

Revenue derived from Subsea Services/Offshore Installation & Construction ("OIC") segment decreased significantly by 45.1% compared to last year.

The profit before taxation for the current financial period of RM15.17 million was decreased as compared to profit before taxation of RM25.06 million recorded for the preceding financial year, with an adverse variance of 39.0%. The profitability of OSV segment reduced by 21.2% due primarily to lower average utilisation rate of chartered vessels.

Subsea Services/OIC segment registered profit before taxation of RM2.19 million for the financial period ended 31 March 2014 as compared to profit before taxation of RM8.24 million recorded for the same period last year.

B2. VARIATION OF RESULTS AGAINST PRECEDING QUARTER

The Group's revenue for the current quarter of RM79.15 million was lower than the preceding quarter's revenue figure of RM85.95 million with an adverse variance of 10.2%. This is mainly due to significantly lower revenue registered by Subsea Services/OIC segment during the current financial quarter under review.

The profit before taxation for the current financial quarter of RM15.17 million was higher than the profit before taxation of RM4.56 million registered for the preceding financial quarter, resulting in a favourable variance exceeding 100%. The financial performance declined in previous financial quarter was mainly attributable to the court decision between the Group against Malaysia tax authority resulting the Group to pay withholding tax approximate of RM7.7 million inclusive penalty.

B3. COMMENTARY ON PROSPECTS

The business outlook for Alam Maritim Group is contributed by the level of energy industry spending by the Oil Companies to increase its oil and natural gas reserves. Based on the current market condition, the domestic oil and gas industry will benefit from the government's explicit and implicit support, given its strategic importance, and remains as the core revenue generator to the nation's economy. As such, the industry is expected to remain robust, involving substantial capital spending by oil majors and thus providing significant cash flows and potential earnings to the Group.

However, concerns regarding the continued slowdown of some European economies, coupled with a weak global economic growth and the threat of rising interest rates remain.

Notwithstanding the above, the Directors will continue to exercise due care in managing and implementing strategies for the Group's business and will ensure that shareholders' values to be enhanced.
