A. NOTES TO THE INTERIM FINANCIAL REPORT

A1 Basis of preparation

The interim financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention except for the revaluation of properties included within property, plant and equipment and investment properties which are stated at fair value.

B. ADDITIONAL INFORMATION REQUIRED BY BURSA MALAYSIA SECURITIES BERHAD'S LISTING REQUIREMENTS

B1 Review of Performance

For the financial year ended 28 February 2009, the Group's revenue increased by 63% from RM313.3 million to RM511.2 million. In line with the revenue recorded, the Group posted higher profit before taxation of RM82 million (FYE08: RM45 million) and higher profit after taxation of RM59.6 million (FYE08: RM34.1 million), an increase of 82% and 75% respectively.

For the current quarter under review with comparison to last year corresponding quarter, the Group registered higher revenue of RM139.4 million (FY08Q4: RM75.7 million). Despite higher revenue achieved, the Group's profit before tax and profit after tax remain comparable to last year corresponding quarter due mainly to a provision for write down of stock of RM9.24 million.

The better performance for current financial year ended 28 February 2009 with comparison to last financial year is mainly attributed to higher manufacturing output, higher sales volume, better product mix from the trading division and contribution from overseas operation.

B2 Variation of results against preceding quarter

In the current quarter under review, the Group's revenue increased marginally from RM132.8 million to RM139.4 million. The Group registered a lower profit after taxation of RM8.78 million for current quarter, as compared to preceding quarter of RM17.25 million, reflecting the provision for write down of stock of RM9.24 million in current quarter.

B3 Prospects

The slowdown of global economy has adversely affected the world's business activities and has created a more challenging environment. The duration, extent and impact of the persisting global financial meltdown are uncertain even while there are tender shoot signs of an economic recovery and increased liquidity in the financial system. Therefore, the Board will adopt a cautious approach to monitor the situation and mitigate any negative impact through diligent administration of operation cost controls and cash flows.

In view of the above, the Board foresees the next financial year will be a challenging year for the Group. Barring any unforeseen circumstances, the Board believes that the performance of the Group for next financial year will be in line with the overall performance of the oil and gas fabrication and other service sector while the long term outlook of the oil and gas industry continues to be positive.

B4 Variance on Profit Forecast/Profit Guarantee

There is no profit forecast or guarantee issued by the Group for the current financial year and quarter under review.
