The significant accounting policies adopted are consistent with the audited financial statements for the financial year ended 20 February 2009.

#### 2 Auditors' Report on the Preceding Annual Financial Statements

There was no qualification in the audit report on the preceding audited annual financial statements.

#### 3 Seasonal or Cyclical Factors

The revenue and profit recorded by the Company in the second half of the financial year is higher due to traditionally higher level of consumer spending during festive seasons in Malaysia.

# B ADDITIONAL INFORMATION REQUIRED BY THE BURSA SECURITIES LISTING REQUIREMENTS

#### 1 Performance Review

For the current quarter ended 20 February 2010, the Company's revenue of RM53.136 million represents growth of 4.4% or RM2.243 million from the corresponding quarter in the preceding year. Although the business environment remained challenging, the Company was able to maintain financial performance in the quarter. Despite the introduction of service tax on credit cards in late 2009, credit card retail transactions in the quarter registered a 16% growth against the previous year.

Correspondingly, the Company recorded profit before tax of RM18.666 million for the quarter, an increase of 1.5% or RM0.281 million from the corresponding quarter in the previous year due to the above factors. The Company recorded profit after tax of RM14.305 million for the quarter ended 20 February 2010, representing growth of 5.2% or RM0.702 million from corresponding quarter in the preceding year.

For the twelve (12) months ended 20 February 2010, the Company's revenue of RM210,144 million, grew by 12.4% or RM23.225 million compared to the corresponding period in previous year. Meanwhile, the Company recorded profit before tax of RM72.226 million for the twelve (12) months ended 20 February 2010, representing growth of 9.5% or RM6.296 million from the preceding year. The Company recorded profit after tax of RM54.275 million for the twelve (12) months ended 20 February 2010, representing growth of 11.3% or RM5.518 million from corresponding preceding year. The growth in revenue, profit before tax and profit after tax for the twelve (12) months is attributable to successful promotional activities and market reach expansion.

#### 2 Material Change in Profit before Taxation of Current Quarter Compared with Preceding Ouarter

The Company registered a profit before taxation of RM18.666 million for the current quarter compared with profit before taxation of RM19.005 million in the preceding quarter ended 20 November 2009.

The profit before tax recorded was marginally lower compared to the preceding quarter, mainly attributable to the decrease in other operating income.

#### 3 Current Year Prospects

The Malaysian economy continues to improve with a positive growth of 4.5% in the fourth quarter (3Q 09: -1.2%), amid strengthened domestic and external demand. Going forward, higher domestic demand is expected, particularly private consumption spending, given the improved consumer and business confidence, and continued access to financing. Accordingly, the Company expects to maintain growth in performance based on its business strategy.

The above is internal management target and is not an estimate, forecast or projection. In addition, this internal target has not been reviewed by our external auditors.
