The Group's revenue for the current quarter stood at RM46.2 million, slight increase of RM14.87 million or 47% compared to 3Q 2014 of RM31.33 million mainly due to sale of one offshore support vessel.

### **Shipbuilding Division**

Shipbuilding division recorded revenue of RM17.62 million mainly due to sale of one offshore support vessel recognised in Quarter 3 2015.

### Ship Charter Division

Revenue of ship charter division decreased 5% compared to 3Q 2014. The unfavourable variance was due to more vessels on short term contracts were off-hired during the quarter under review.

Although revenue for the current quarter increased by RM14.87 million or 47%, the group suffered loss before tax of RM11.18 million for the current quarter compared to profit before tax of RM211,000 in 3Q 2014. The loss is after the reversal of doubtful debt of RM2.2 million provided in 1Q 2015 due to payment has been received from the client . The adverse result of current quarter was mainly due to impairment charge on inventories and assets amounted to RM5.86 million. The results further impacted by the share of losses in joint venture companies. For the current quarter the group also taken up forex loss of RM918,000. However year to date, the group still has a net forex gain of RM1.87 million. Whereas in 3Q 2014, the adverse result was set off by forex gain and gain on disposal of vessels from the fleet.

The Group's revenue for the current financial period achieved at RM116.08 million compared to RM99.23 million in the corresponding financial period last year mainly attributed to higher revenue from vessel sale.

The Group recorded loss before tax of RM6.43 million in the current financial period against profit of RM7.74 million in the corresponding period of preceding year due to drop in utilisation and charter rate of some of the vessels and share of losses in joint venture companies. In addition to that, the drop was further exacerbated by the impairment charge of RM5.86 million in total on inventories and assets taken up in the current financial period. On the other hand, preceding year profit was attributed to higher profit margin, share of profit from associate and joint venture company and gain on disposal of vessels from the fleet.

The subsidiary filed its statement of claim against BPS on 8 May 2013 for interest, damages, costs and expenses incurred by the company for breaches of the contract by BPS. BPS has filed a statement of defence and counterclaim on 7 June 2013. The arbitration is ongoing as parties exchange requests for disclosure.
