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## UNAUDITED INTERIM FINANCIAL REPORT FOR THE FOURTH QUARTER ENDED 31 MAY2015

## PART A – SELECTED EXPLANATORY NOTES PURSUANT TO THE FINANCIAL REPORTING STANDARDS ("FRS") 134: INTERIM FINANCIAL REPORTING

#### 1 Basis of Preparation

The interim financial statements are unaudited and have been prepared in accordance with Financial Reporting Standard ("FRS") 134 - Interim Financial Reporting and Paragraph 9.22 of the Main Market Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad. These financial statements also comply with IAS 34: Interim Financial Reporting issued by the International Accounting Standard Board (IASB).

The condensed consolidated interim financial statements should be read in conjunction with the Audited Financial Statements of the Group for the year ended 31 May 2014 and the accompanying explanatory notes attached. These explanatory notes attached to the interim financial statements provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group.

### 2. Changes in accounting policies

The quarterly consolidated interim financial statements have been prepared by applying accounting policies consistent with that used in the most recent audited financial statements for the year ended 31 May 2014 except for the adoption of the new/ revised/ amendments to FRS which are applicable to the Group with effect from 1 January 2014.

Management foresees that the initial application of the new/ revised/ amendments FRSs will not have any significant impacts on the financial statements.

#### Malaysian Financial Reporting Standards ("MFRS") Framework

In November 2011, the Malaysian accounting Standards Board ("MASB") issued a new MASB approved accounting framework, the MFRS framework. The issuance was made in conjunction with the MASB's plan to converge with International Financial Reporting Standards ("IFRS") in 2012. The MFRS framework is fully IFRS-compliant framework and equivalent to IFRSs.

The MFRS framework is to be applied by all entities other than private entities for annual periods beginning on or after 1 January 2012, with the exception of entities that are within the scope of MFRS 141 Agriculture and/or IC Interpretation 15 Agreements for Construction of Real Estate, including their parents, significant investors and venturers ("Transitioning Entities"). Transitioning Entities are allowed to defer the adoption of the MFRS framework to annual periods beginning on or after 1 January 2015.

Being a Transitioning Entity as defined above, the Group has elected to defer the adoption of the MFRS framework to the financial year ending 31 May 2016. Management is currently examining the financial impacts of transition to the MFRS framework.

#### 3. Auditors' Report on Preceding Annual Financial Statements

The auditors' report on the preceding audited financial statements of the Company and its subsidiaries for the financial year ended 31 May 2014 were not subject to any qualification.

## 4. Seasonal or Cyclical Factors

The Group's performance is not significantly affected by seasonal or cyclical factors.



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#### 5. Unusual Items

There was no item, which is unusual because of their nature, size or incidence that has affected the assets, liabilities, equity, net income or cash flows of the Group for the current quarter.

#### 6. Material Changes in Estimates

There were no changes in estimates of amounts that have had a material effect in the current quarter.

#### 10. Contingent Liabilities

Perusahaan Saudee Sdn. Bhd ("PSSB") received two Letters of Claim from Malaysia Royal Customs Department for non-payment of sales tax and late penalty totaling RM9,311,000 as follows:-

- (i) Letter of Claim dated 19 January 2015 for sales tax amounting to RM1,334,000 covering period 1 November 2011 to 31 October 2014 relating to sales of beef burgers and rabbit burgers and penalty amounting to RM324,000 up to 31 January 2015.
- (ii) Letter of Claim dated 25 February 2015 for sales tax amounting to RM6,154,000 covering period 1 January 2012 to 31 October 2014 relating to sales of frozen chicken burgers, sausages, nuggets and balls said to be packed in air-tight containers and penalty amounting to RM1,499,000 up to 24 February 2015.

Management has engaged consultant and legal adviser to appeal for the claims. Based on the legal representation letter dated 21 July 2015 from Peter Huang & Richard, they are of the opinion that there are valid reasons and sufficient evidence to substantiate the appeal to waive the sales tax and penalty payable. Hence, management is of the opinion that no provision of liability is to be made.



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### 11. Events subsequent to the Balance Sheet date

There were no events subsequent to the end of the financial period ended 31 May 2015 that have not been reflected in the interim financial statements as at the date of this report.

#### 12. Changes in the Composition of the Group

There were no changes in the composition of the Group during the quarter under review.

PART B: EXPLANATORY NOTES PURSUANT TO APPENDIX 9B OF THE LISTING REQUIREMENTS OF BURSA MALAYSIA SECURITIES BERHAD

#### 1. Review of Performance

The revenue for the Group for the current quarter ended 31 May 2015 increased to RM40.7 million compared to its corresponding quarter of RM36.6 million. This represented a 11% increase in turnover. However gross profit was reduced by RM2.7 million (55%) to RM 2.2 million on account of a 22% increase in cost of sales exacerbated by the weakening ringgit against the US Dollars which is the predominant currency of the Group's imports of raw materials and the deeper discounts given to boost sales following the implementation of GST on 1st April 2015. The result in the current quarter is a loss before tax of RM2.4 million representing an increase in loss of RM2.3 million compared with its corresponding quarter. Additional contributory factor for the decrease in profits was an impairment adjustment to the assets of RM0.6 million to a non-active subsidiary, Nutriveg Sdn Bhd.

The revenue for the financial year ended 31 May 2015 was RM167 million, which is RM18 million (12%) higher from that of RM149.1 million recorded in the previous year. This is in line with the management's strategy to boost market share through increasing sales. The weaker performance in Quarter 4 contributed by external extenuating factors already mentioned and the impairment adjustment, resulted in the group achieving an overall loss before tax for the year of RM2.2 million as compared to a profit before tax of RM1.0 million the year before.

The revenue for the current quarter ended 31 May 2015 was RM4.8 million lower than its preceding quarter due to a tighter market condition affecting quarter 4. On 1<sup>st</sup> April 2015, GST was introduced nationwide and the 6% GST had a dampening effect on the market. With aggressive marketing promotions, the group managed to improve its revenue compared to its corresponding quarter even though it is still lower than the previous quarter.

#### 3. Current Year Prospects

The current year is expected to be more challenging with the weak ringgit and GST affecting margins and market conditions. The management has put in place actions to boost the performance of the Saudee group by enhancing operational efficiency and boosting its product margins through the introduction of higher end products. The coming year should see the results of the transformative management actions impacting more strongly on the financial results.

The strategic cooperation with MyAngkasa is progressing well and two co-operative projects - (1) to supply products to its members in schools and (2) to supply Saudee's products in mosques, commenced in June 2015.

The current focus for the business in Malaysia continues on enhancing production capacity, efficiency and enlarging market shares for the group's products both locally and abroad. The group will be introducing a slew of new and re-packaged products this year which will be supported by an aggressive marketing and promotion campaign to strengthen the group's branding.
