Part A - Explanatory notes pursuant to Malaysian Financial Reporting Standard 134

1. Basis of preparation

These condensed consolidated interim financial statements are unaudited and have been prepared in accordance with MFRS 134 Interim Financial Reporting and paragraph 9.22 of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad. These condensed consolidated interim financial statements also comply with IAS 34 Interim Financial Reporting issued by the International Accounting Standards Board.

These condensed consolidated interim financial statements should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2022. The explanatory notes attached to these condensed consolidated interim financial statements provide an explanation of events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group since the financial year ended 31 December 2022.

The Group's Sales of Goods segment continues to be the main contributor of the Group's revenue. The revenue from Sales of Goods segment decreased significantly from RM10.83 million to RM8.14 million due to lower sales relating to Sales of Goods segment generated in the current period. The overall segment's profit for the period has been decreased to a loss of RM0.64 million as compared to the overall segment's profit of RM2.33 million in the corresponding quarter in the preceeding year mainly because there was a significant gain on disposal in the corresponding period in the preceeding year.

The decrease in revenue from Construction segment in current period as compared to the corresponding period in the preceeding year was mainly due to several new projects obtained not yet commence during the period.

The Group's revenue for current quarter ("3Q2023") ended 30 September 2023 decreased by approximately RM0.82 million or 18.0% to RM3.72 million as compared to the corresponding quarter in the preceding year. The decrease in revenue for 3Q2023 was due to the decrease in revenue from the Sales of Goods segment by RM0.64 million and Construction segment by RM0.18 million due to slower external demand as a result of weakening global trade.

In the current year quarter, the Group had generated an operating profit of RM0.59 million as compared to the preceeding year corresponding quarter's operating profit of RM0.60 million even with lower revenue due to some cost control measures implemented

The Group's revenue for current year-to-date ("9M2023") ended 30 September 2023 shown a decrease of 32.8% to RM9.46 million as compared to RM14.08 million recorded in the preceeding year period mainly due to the decrease in revenue generated from Sales of Goods segment by RM2.69 million and decrease in Construction segment by RM1.93 million.

The Group's profit before tax decreased to loss before tax of RM1.29 million in 9M2023 as compared to profit before tax of RM1.27 million in 9M2022 which is mainly due to higher operating cost recorded in current period and gain from disposal of property made in the corresponding period in the preceding year.

The Group's revenue increased by RM0.87 million in current quarter as compared to the immediate preceding quarter ended 30 June 2023. The Sales of Goods segment's revenue increased by RM0.26 million and the Construction segment's revenue increased by RM0.61 million.

In current quarter, the Group generated a gross profit of RM1.39 million and derived at profit after tax of RM0.20 million mainly due to higher revenue and lower operating costs. This was due the Group has implemented certain cost control measures.

21. Commentary on prospects

According to the press released by Malaysian Rating Corporation Bhd (MARC), the GDP growth rate of Malaysia in Q3 2023 is likely to moderate and be slightly lower than the level of 5.6% seen in Q2 2023. The economic experts are in view that the external variables influencing growth, which impacted the economy in the first half of 2023, including the United States (US) Federal Reserve's (Fed) monetary stance, the US dollar and disappointing China's rebound, are likely to have impact on Malaysia in the second half of 2023.

The Board anticipates that the prospects for the financial year ending 31 December 2023 will continue to be challenging. The Group will continue to focus on maximising efficiency and timely delivery of quality products, promoting the Group's products and services as to ensure the long-term strength of the businesses and operations as well as preparing for diversity of business by commencing the property development activities.
