Part A - Explanatory notes pursuant to Financial Reporting Standard 134

1. Basis of preparation

The interim financial statements is unaudited and has been prepared in accordance with Financial Reporting Standards ("FRS") 134: Interim Financial Reporting issued by the Malaysian Accounting Standards Board ("MASB") and Paragraph 9.22 of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad for the Main Market.

The interim financial statements should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements for the financial year ended 31 December 2013. These explanatory notes attched to the interim financial statements provide an explanation of the events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the financial position and performance of the Group since the financial year ended 31 December 2013.

Revenue

The Group's revenue for current quarter ("4Q2014") ended 31 December 2014 has increased by RM1.73 million or 15.0% to RM13.22 million as compared to corresponding quarter in the preceding year. The increase in revenue for 4Q2014 was due to revenue generated from property development segment amounted to RM3.86 million however partially off-set by the decrease in sales of goods segment by RM1.41 million and construction segment by RM0.72 million.

Profit before tax

The Group's profit before tax for 4Q2014 has decreased by RM0.36 million to RM0.33 million as compared to profit before tax of RM0.68 million in corresponding quarter in preceding year. The decrease in profit before tax in 4Q2014 is mainly due to the decrease in operating profit by RM1.28 million and the decrease in other income by RM0.44 million, however off-set the decrease of the administrative, general and selling expenses by RM1.31 million in the current quarter under review. Higher administrative, general and selling expenses in corresponding quarter in preceding year was due to impairment loss on trade receivables amounted to RM1.00 million.

Revenue

The Group's revenue for current year-to-date ("12M2014") ended 31 December 2014 has slight increased by RM0.24 million or 0.6% to RM39.95 million as compared to corresponding period in the preceding year. The increase in revenue for 12M2014 was due to the revenue generated from property development segment amounted to RM3.86 million however partially off-set by the decrease in sales of goods segment by RM0.55 million and the decrease in construction segment by RM3.07 million.

Profit before tax

The Group's profit before tax for 12M2014 has slight increased by RM0.10 million to RM1.65 million in comparison with the corresponding period in the preceding year. The increase in the profit before tax is mainly due to decrease of the administrative, general and selling expenses by RM1.03 million and the reduce of finance costs by RM0.48 million, however partially off-set by the decrease in operating profit by RM1.13 million and decrease of other income by RM0.28 million. Higher administrative, general and selling expenses in corresponding period in preceding year was due to impairment loss on trade receivables amounted to RM1.00 million while higher other income in corresponding period in preceding year resulted from the reversal impairment loss on trade receivables amounted to RM0.31 million.

The Group recorded slight decreased in profit before tax of by RM1,000 for the current quarter under review as compared to profit before tax in the immediate preceding quarter.

21. Commentary on prospects

The Malaysian economy is expected to sustain its growth momentum between 5% to 6% in year 2015, driven by resilient domestic demand and improvement in external environment. Domestics demand is expected to remain strong and continue to be the driver of growth. Private investment remain vibrant is expected to record a double-digit growth supported by the on-going Economic Transformation Programme ("ETP") projects. Construction sector is forecasted to grow at 10.7% while manufacturing and sevices sector forecasted to grow at 5.5% and 5.6% respectively which lead economic drive in year 2015. The strong performance of the construction sector is expected to continue, largely supported by the civil engineering and residential sub-sectors.
